

April 17, 2013

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met for a regular session on April 17, 2013, in the Eureka Annex of the Lincoln County Courthouse. Present are Commissioner Ron Downey, Commissioner Mike Cole, Executive Assistant Bill Bischoff and Clerk and Recorder Tammy Lauer. Commissioner Tony Berget is ill.

10:30 AM: Commissioner Downey **opened the meeting** with the Pledge of Allegiance.

10:30 AM: **Richard Stavenow**: Mr. Stavenow came to talk about a road that Tungsten Holdings is building behind his property. He said the road is so steep that there is no way he can get to the back of his property. He brought pictures. Tim White confirmed that it is very steep. When the preliminary plat was approved documents stated that it would be the responsibility of Tungsten to make a road for Stevenows to access their property. The commissioners agreed to contact Tungsten and will contact Mr. Stevenow afterward.

10:45 AM: **Rose and Steve Carvey from the Tobacco Valley Rod and Gun Club** have come to ask if the property the shooting range is on can be taken off the tax rolls. The commissioners do not have the authority to do that, however, Commissioner Cole has the forms that need to be turned in to the Department of Revenue. Commissioner Cole gave Rose the forms and she will submit them to the DOR.

10:55 AM: The **Troy Dispatch Board** would like to appoint Dennis Dupuis to the open position of the board. Commissioner Cole moved to approve the appointment and it carried.

11:15 AM: The commissioners read the **minutes of the March 20, March 27, April 3, and April 10, 2013 meetings**. Commissioner Cole moved to approve the minutes as written and it carried.

1:30 PM: **Blue Mountain RV Park**, 20 spaces for recreational vehicles on 36.8 acres, public hearing: This is a public hearing for the Blue Mountain RV Park to add 20 spaces to the already 35 unit park. Kristin Smith, Planning Director, presented the proposal for the RV Park and the conditions. Kristin opened the meeting for public comment. Frank Votapka said he has a draft of the ATV rule that will be part of the rules as suggested by the only comment received by email from JFLI Trust. There was no other public comment. Commissioner Cole moved to approve the recreational park as preliminary approval with the additional condition and it carried.
