10:00 AM: The commissioners read the minutes of the March 19, 2014, meeting. Commissioner Cole moved to approve the minutes as written and it carried.

10:30 AM: The commissioners had a phone conference with Dan Dinning, Commissioner of Boundary County, Idaho, concerning the Pilgrim Creek Timber Sale.

10:50 AM: The commissioners discussed the Forest Plan and preparation for the meeting with the Forest Service.

11:00 AM: Commissioner Berget has been appointed to the Rail Service Competition Council. He attended a meeting on Monday in Helena and informed the other commissioners of what was discussed.

11:10 AM: The Sanders County Commissioners spoke with Lincoln County Commissioner on a conference phone call about the Secured Rural Schools funding. There is a meeting next month in Portland however, there is currently no bill to attach the SRS to so the funding looks grim for the 2014/2015 year.

1:00 AM: The commissioners discussed the revenue reduction in Lincoln County and what can be done to turn it around. There was a discussion about a trip to Denver and Washington DC to meet with key departments about the plight of Lincoln County.
