Fire Briefing

The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met for a special session on September 18, 2017, in the Lincoln County Courthouse, Libby, Montana. Present were Commissioner Cole, Commissioner Peck, Commissioner Bennett, County Administrator Darren Coldwell and Deputy Clerk and Recorder Chris Nelson.

9:00 AM **Fire Update:** Present were Brent Teske, Ernie Anderson, Heather Benjamin, Kathi Hooper, Brad Lord, and John Blodgett.

Brent said the EOC call center is not being manned but the calls are being forwarded to Brenda Rebo in the health department. Ernie said he came in over the weekend to print a map for the Type II team that showed the Blue Mountain repeater on it. Brad said the West Fork Fire was at 19,497 acres with 396 people working the fire that is estimated to reach 100% containment by October 7th. The Moose Creek Fire was estimated to be at 100% containment by the end of October. Darren said that they would probably not be doing a 9 AM briefing any longer as it has slowed considerably but would schedule one if anything came up.
