

New Business	<b>Mental Health Resource Discussion</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Amy Fantozzi gave presentation overiewing the types of mental health services available at Western Montana Mental Health. A diagnosis is needed to access those services. Telehealth is being utilized heavily, as isolation from the pandemic has had adverse effects on many clients.</li> <li>Laura states there are services available at the hospital as well.</li> </ul>

Public Health	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Jennifer McCully updated the Board on the 2019-nCoV or 2019 Novel Coronavirus numbers in the county. CARD has the new hire Penny taking over the drive-thru testing now. The call line is providing that number to the people inquiring about testing.</li> </ul>	
Environmental Health	<b>DPHHS Cooperative Agreement Amendment:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DPHHS provided an amendment to the annual cooperative agreement that provides payment to the Health Department for inspection. This amendment allows for payment for virtual inspections and COVID outreach. Amendment was approved and signed.</li> </ul>	

	<p><b>PM10 and PM2.5 Redesignation Status:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Libby area was designated nonattainment for PM10 in 1991 but met the standard from 1992 through 2017. DEQ requested redesignation in February 2019. EPA approved the request and Libby area is now designated "Limited Maintenance Area".</li> <li>• DEQ sent request to EPA in June 2020 to redesignate Libby area as attainment for PM2.5. EPA has 6 months to review and additional 12 months to act.</li> </ul> <p><b>Animal Control Regulation Revision:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deputy County Attorney Copperstone provided revisions to existing animal control regulation. Revisions are corrections and clarifications and do not change intent of regulation. Sara motioned, Deb seconded. Revisions approved.</li> </ul>

	<p><b>PEN Regulation Adoption:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Property Evaluation Notification (PEN) Regulation: The PEN Regulation is currently adopted but not voted effective. Jason Rappe from MT Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) asked the BOH when they were going to vote the regulation to be effective. Virginia passed the message to the BOH members. The reply : the regulation was still being considered. The BOH was informed that July 1<sup>st</sup> was the first day of Operations and Maintenance (O&amp;M) however, a memorandum of agreement was not agreed upon between DEQ and Lincoln County. Both parties are working towards an agreement. ARP is working closely with the BOH and the Lincoln County Commissioners and will continue to focus on essential tasks that support the Libby/Troy community related to activities in the Superfund site and managing exposure to Libby amphibole (LA) asbestos.</li> <li>- The property owner who recently had an asbestos abatement done on his property found vermiculite containing insulation (VCI) on top of blown-in insulation in knee walls of the structure. Insulation boards were compromised by other contractors before the initial clean-up which allowed small amount of VCI to get into the knee walls. ARP contacted the same abatement company, informed them of the situation, and they organized a 2<sup>nd</sup> trip to remove the remaining VCI and contaminated</li> </ul>	ARP
