We represent the City/County Board of Health for Lincoln County ("Board"). We have been contacted by the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") regarding Superfund Cooperative Agreement V 96803401 ("Grant"). Specifically, the EPA has requested additional information as outlined in the following attached correspondence:

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
of the time included on the Draft Statement and whether that time was incurred in administering the Grant.
