Lincoln County is the recipient of a grant through the Montana State Historical Records Board. The grant program, called “BLITZ” is to provide funding and support for a week-long processing event with significant archival collections, a need for assistance and a well-organized plan.

The “Blitz” event will be to inventory, flattening and storing/archiving old 1900’s canvas maps of Lincoln County that have been stored in a courthouse vault.
