

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, an emergency condition now exists which affects the preservation of county roads which could cause damage or deterioration risking the safety of users of the roads; now


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lincoln County that Resolution No. 479 (Road Restriction Ordinance) shall be amended as follows:


1. This amendment shall only be in force for the roads within the Eureka Commissioner District. Roads within the Libby and Troy Commissioner District will remain subject to original Resolution No. 479.
2. During periods of time when a county road may be seriously damaged or destroyed by deterioration, rain, snow, or other climate conditions, Lincoln County may prohibit the operation of or impose restrictions on the weight and speed of any vehicle using the roadways as allowed by Section 62-20-128, M.C.A.
 - a. During times prior to spring break up, the Eureka Road Foreman may designate restrictions that only allow full load hauling during the hours of 2:00 a.m. through 12:00 noon.
 - b. When spring break up occurs, weight restrictions during this period shall be limited to 350 pounds per inch of tire width during the hours of 2:00 a.m. through 12:00 noon.
 - c. Speed limits for loaded trucks during these time periods shall be limited to 25 miles per hour.
 - d. Exceptions to these restrictions may be reviewed on an individual basis and granted by the Eureka Road Foreman by special permit.
 - e. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to penalties set forth in 61-20-147, M.C.A. and any civil remedy allowed by law for damage caused.


This ordinance is declared to be an emergency and shall take effect immediately and be in effect for 90 days.


