ORDER OF THE LINCOLN COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER DRAFT – November 23, 2020

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2020, the Governor of Montana, in consultation with public health authorities, issued a directive limiting size for public gatherings and events and limiting bar and restaurant capacity and hours; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 50-2-116(g) of the Montana Code Annotated, in order to carry out the purposes of the public health system, the City-County Board of Health for Lincoln County shall protect the public from the introduction and spread of communicable disease; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 50-2-118 of the Montana Code Annotated, the local health officer, in carrying out the purpose of the public health system, shall take steps to limit contact between people in order to protect the public health from imminent threats, including but not limited to ordering the closure of buildings or facilities where people congregate and cancelling events; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to Title 50, Chapter 2, Part 1, and specifically Section 50-2-118 of the Montana Code Annotated,

- This Order adopts and incorporates herein in its entirety the Governor of the State of Montana's November 17, 2020 directive. The terms of that directive are incorporated as though fully restated herein; and
- 2) This Order is effective beginning 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 24, 2020, and shall remain effective until the Health Officer revises or rescinds it; and
- 3) To the limited extent any previous Health Officer Orders are in direct conflict with the provisions of this Order, they are superseded. Otherwise the Health Officer's July 21, 2020 Order regarding usage of face coverings remains in full force and effect; and
- 4) Violations of this Order shall be punishable pursuant to Sections 50-2-123 & 124, Montana Code Annotated and any other applicable laws.
