Contaminated water from rainy creek has continued contamination. EPA has spread fibers throughout the superfund site. OU1-DTSAR building wasn’t tested and members have gotten sick. There have been previous steering committees that were more carrot than stick with ICs. If you get too heavy handed there will be more midnight hauling of contaminated material. IC’s should not be punitive. Funding cannot come back on property owners. ICSC has limited understanding of issues because most of the member have not been here for 17 years. Nick leading the ICSC is a problem because he directs the ICSC where he wants them to go.
