RESOLUTION TO APPOINT LINCOLN COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR LINCOLN COUNTY, MONTANA FINDS:

- 1. Historically, Lincoln County has had difficulty filling the Superintendent of Schools elected official position through the regular election process. The position currently remains vacant, and
- In the case of such a vacant elected official position, Section 7-4-2206, M.C.A. authorizes
 Boards of County Commissioners to appoint a qualified individual to serve as an interim
 elected official until which time the vacancy is filled through the next general election
 pursuant to 13-15-406, M.C.A., and
- 3. Having met the requirements of 7-4-2206, M.C.A. and 13-15-406, M.C.A. with respect to public hearing and notice, therefore

THE BOARD RESOLVES:

The Board of Lincoln County Commissioners hereby resolves to appoint a qualified individual to serve as an interim County Superintendent of Schools until which time the vacancy is filled through the next general election.

THE BOARD FURTHER RESOLVES:

- 1. If a provision of this resolution conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted resolution, this resolution will prevail.
- 2. This resolution and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of the resolution will not be affected.





- 3. This resolution will be effective immediately upon adoption, in accordance with § 7-5-123, MCA.
- 4. This Board directs that this resolution be entered into the minutes and signed by the Chair of the Board in accordance with § 7-5-121, MCA.
