- 3. The Midvale Water/Sewer District Board requests that the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners approve the Midvale Water/Sewer District Corporate Resolution and dissolve the Midvale Water/Sewer District.

WHEREAS, the Midvale Water and Sewer District ("District") has transferred all its assets to the Town of Eureka and desires to dissolve the District pursuant to Montana Code Ann. Sec. 7-13-2351 (2019), and

WHEREAS, the District has received a petition signed by more than 50% of the property owners in the District to dissolve the District, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the dissolution of the District was set for January 29, 2021 at 1:00 pm at the Law Office of J. Tiffin Hall, PLLC. Notice of the hearing was published in the Tobacco Valley Newspaper for two successive weeks. A true and correct copy of the Affidavit of Publication is attached hereto as Exhibit A and by this reference incorporated herein, and

WHEREAS, at the scheduled time of the hearing no interested persons appeared to testify, and

WHEREAS, after the hearing the board determined that the dissolution of the District is in the best interest of the public, that there were no outstanding debts of the District and there are no assets remaining to be distributed,

WHEREFORE the board recommended that the District be dissolved and that a resolution be sent to the Lincoln County Board of County Commissioners for approval.
