Herbicide Cost Share Program

In the interest of assisting small private landowners with the cost of applying herbicides to control Ventenata dubia and other new invader noxious weeds, the Lincoln County Weed Control Board is offering a cost share program in which (75%) of the cost of herbicides up to \$500 will be shared by the Lincoln County Cost Share Program. The terms and conditions of this program are as follows.

- 1. The cost share program applies only to Ventenata dubia and other new invader **Noxious Weeds**.
- 2. There is an upper payment limit of \$500.00 per applicant/landowner per year.
- 3. The program covers 75% of the cost of herbicides.
- 4. The cost of surfactants and dyes will be covered by the landowner.
- 5. Equipment and labor are an in-kind contribution for the program.

Steps to Take

- 1. Complete application and return it the *Lincoln County Weed Department,* _____, *Libby, MT* 59923.
- 2. The Weed Department Supervisor, Weed Board Chairman or Ventenata Program Coordinator will review and let you know if the application is approved.
- **3.** Once approved you can purchase the appropriate herbicides.
- After purchasing and applying herbicide, send receipts and completed Claim Sheet (last sheet) to the same address. REMEMBER TO FOLLOW THE LABELS

Note: If misapplication of an herbicide occurs, the cost share will be denied.

If a misapplication is deemed to be harmful to the environment or the surrounding area, the proper regulatory agency may be notified.

If you plan to employ a Commercial Applicator:

- 1. Applicator must bill the herbicide cost as a separate line item.
- 2. 75% of these costs up to \$500 will qualify for Cost Share Reimbursement
- 3. Surfactants, Dye, and Labor costs will not be reimbursed.

NOTE: ALL COST SHARE REIMBURSEMENT MUST BE TURNED IN NO LATER THEN NOVEMBER 1ST!!
