Assistant Election Administrator Leigh Riggleman submitted the Abstract of Votes for the Bull Lake Rural Fire District Levy Election held May 12, 2015. **Motion** by County Treasurer Nancy Higgins to accept the Abstract of Votes/Canvass as presented. Second by Clerk of Court Susan Farmer and so ordered upon unanimous consent. The ballot requested electors to vote for or against a permanent levy of 38 mills. Gary explained the renewal options for the county and explained the increase of approximately 11.5% for the continued county insurance plan as a benefit to employees. There are several factors for the increase which include inflation in the medical industry that drives up premiums, prescription cost, and a percent that goes to cover cost of the Affordable Care Act. The renewal is based 50% on how the trust did as a whole and 50% on how the county did in medical claims. There is a new option for the county to consider for employees that utilizes a health savings account. Gary and the HR Department will coordinate efforts to further discuss all options.
