To Whom It May Concern:

EmKayan Village County Water & Sewer District is a self sufficient water and sewer district. We operate within the money collected from water fees. We receive no money from the county to operate.

We rely on the county only to collect funds through property taxes to pay off a government loan we took out in 2010 to update our water system.

I am enclosing a schedule of our loan payments that fluctuates from year to year. The 1^{st} payment is due July 1, the 2^{nd} payment is due on January 1 of each year.

The amount collected by the county is based on the number of lot owners in EmKayan Village which is, as of now, is 81. I am enclosing the copy of last year's budget that shows the amount collected by taxes. This year would be exactly the same unless people who have more than one lot have combined them into one.

I hope this is sufficient for your budget request.

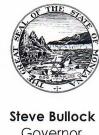
