RESOLUTION TO AMEND TREGO FORTINE STRYKER FIRE SERVICE AREA FEE SCHEDULE

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR LINCOLN COUNTY, **MONTANA FINDS:**

- 1. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners created the Trego/Fortine/Stryker Fire Service Area under the provision of Section 7-33-2401 M.C.A.
- 2. On March 16, 2022, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners received a request from the Board of Trustees of the Trego/Fortine/Stryker Fire Service Area to amend the fee schedule as follows:

Class 1 – Single Family Residence	From \$50/year to \$100/year
Class 2 - Multi-occupied dwellings, bars,	
restaurants, churches, small motels (5 units or	From \$76/year to \$152/year
less) and similar businesses	
Class 3 – Service Stations, small lumber mills	From \$112/year to \$224/year
(5 employees or less) and similar businesses	

- 3. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners passed Resolution 2022-09. A Resolution of Intent Trego/Fortine/Stryker Fire Service Area Amended Fee Schedule dated March 23, 2022.
- 4. A Public Notice was issued pursuant to Section 7-1-2121 M.C.A.
- 5. A Public Hearing was held on April 14, 2022 at 6:30 pm at the Fortine Gym located at 358 Meadow Creek Road, Fortine Montana for the purpose of public comment for or against the fee schedule amendment as set forth above.
- 6. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners has considered all comments and has concluded that the amendment to the fee schedule of the Trego/Fortine/Stryker Fire Service Area should be adopted as set forth above.

THE BOARD RESOLVES:

1. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the fee schedule rates to be charged to owners of structures within the Trego/Fortine/Stryker Area pursuant to 7-33-2404 M.C.A. as set forth above.

- 1. If a provision of this resolution conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted resolution, this resolution will prevail.
- 2. This resolution and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are severable. If any part, sentence, clause or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of the resolution will not be affected.
- 3. This resolution will be effective immediately upon adoption, in accordance with § 7-5-123, MCA.
- 4. This Board directs that this resolution be entered into the minutes and signed by the Chair of the Board in accordance with § 7-5-121, MCA.
