

IN THE SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 25
TWP. 30 N., R. 31 W., M.P.M.



DESCRIPTION

A rectangular tract of land near Libby in Lincoln County, Montana, lying wholly within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25 Twp. 30 N., R. 31 W., M.P.M., containing 0.500 acres, more or less, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point S 89°58' W 169.22 feet from the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25 Twp. 30 N., R. 31 W., M.P.M., which point lies on the north line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence, along said north line, S 89°58' W 132.0 feet; thence, leaving said north line, S 0°45' E 165.0 feet; thence, N 89°58' E 132.0 feet; thence, N 0°45' W 165.0 feet to the point of beginning.
