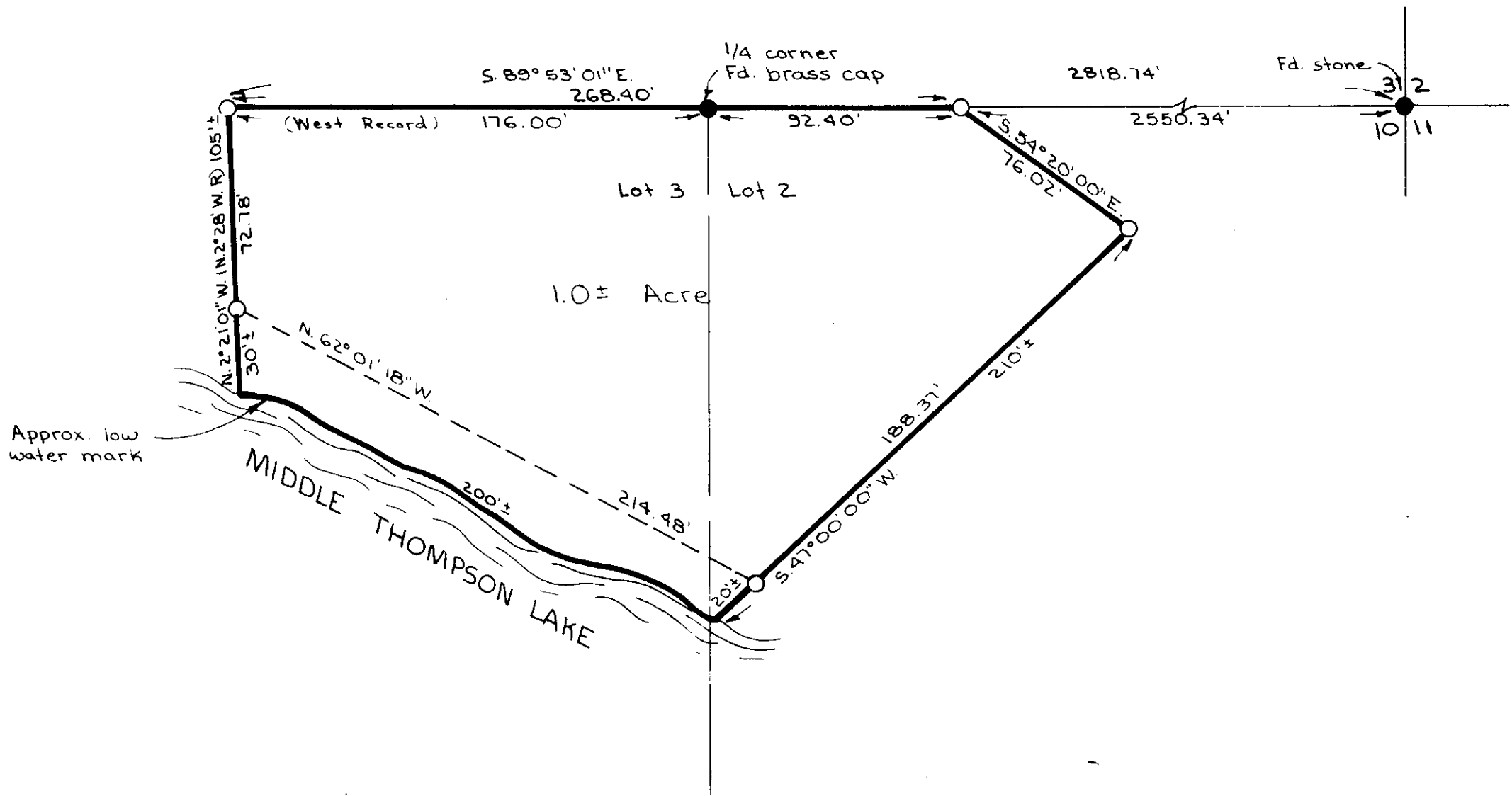


CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY
Lots 2 & 3, Sec. 10, T26N R27W

OWNER: REELY BROTHERS, a co-partnership composed of JOHN L. REELY & WILLIAM E. S. REELY

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Those portions of Lots 2 and 3, Section 10, Township 26 North, Range 27 West, Lincoln County, Montana described as follows:
Beginning at a point on the North line of Lot 3 bearing North 89° 53' 01" West (West Record) 176.00 feet from the Northeast corner of Lot 3; then along the North line of Lots 2 and 3 South 89° 53' 01" East 268.40 feet; then South 54° 20' 00" East 76.02 feet; then South 47° 00' 00" West 210 feet more or less to the approximate low water mark of Middle Thompson Lake; then Northwest along the low water mark 200 feet more or less to a point therein bearing South 2° 21' 01" East from the Point of Beginning; then North 2° 21' 01" West (North 2° 28' West Record) 105 feet more or less to the Point of Beginning, containing 1.0 acre of land more or less.

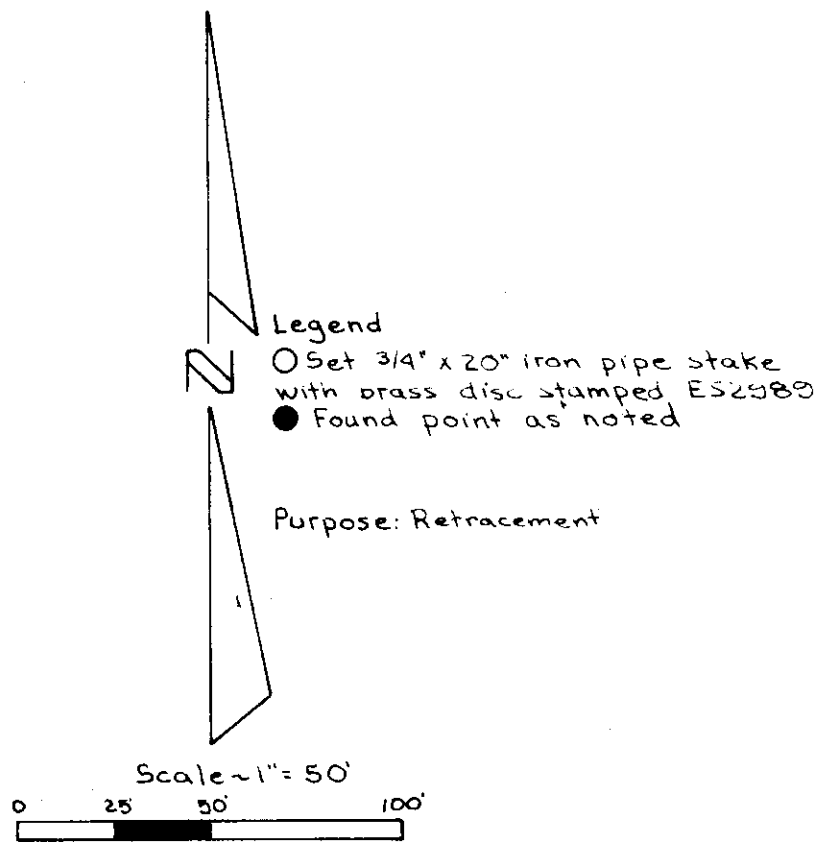
