DESCRIPTION

A rectangular tract of land near Libby in Lincoln County, Montana, lying wholly within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24 Twp. 30 N., R. 31 W., M.P.M., containing 0.011 acre, more or less, and more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at a point on the southerly right of way line of a Public Road at a distance of 20.0 feet measured at right angles from the centerline thereof, which point of beginning lies South 484.0 feet and East 415.0 feet from the West 1/4 Corner of Section 24 Twp. 30 N., R. 31 W., M.P.M.; thence, from said point of beginning, continuing along said southerly right of way line, East 5.0 feet; thence, leaving said southerly right of way line, South 100.0 feet; thence, West 5.0 feet; thence, North 100.0 feet to the point of beginning.

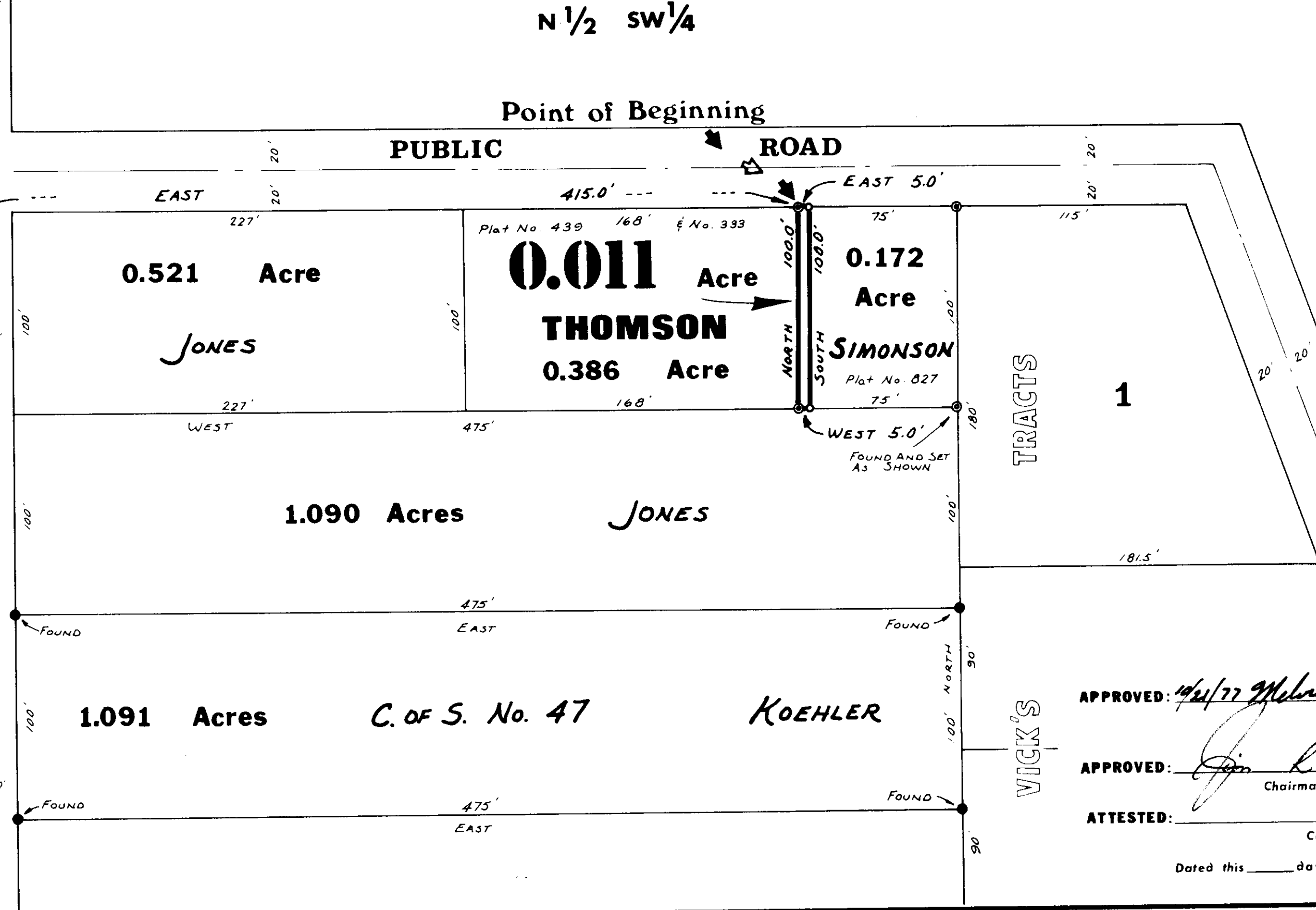
