SURVEY HISTORY

Section 35 T.35N., R.26W., P.M.M. and Sections 2 and 3, T.34N., R.26W., P.M.M. were originally surveyed in August and September, 1894 by Frank L. Sizer and Abram L. Jaqueth. Bureau of Land Management remonumentation was in 1959 for all three sections, with additional monumentation in Section 2 in 1967. Two private surveys were done in Sections 4 and 9, T.34N., R.26W., P.M.M., which adjoin the subject Section 3. M.L. Haiges broke down said Section 9 in September, 1979 (C. of S. No. 679) and G.E. Bunton subdivided part of said Section 4 in August, 1983 (C. of S. No. 1212).

NOTE

The January, 1984 amendment of this C. of S. corrects some of the bearings, distances, and areas in Section 3. The February, 1984 amendment re-establishes the southwest corner of Section 3 at the 'best' location as agreed upon between Jack H. Ninneman and Tom Hill, USFS. The breakdown of Section 3 thus changes slightly. Additional ties were made in Section 35, also slightly changing the breakdown of this section.

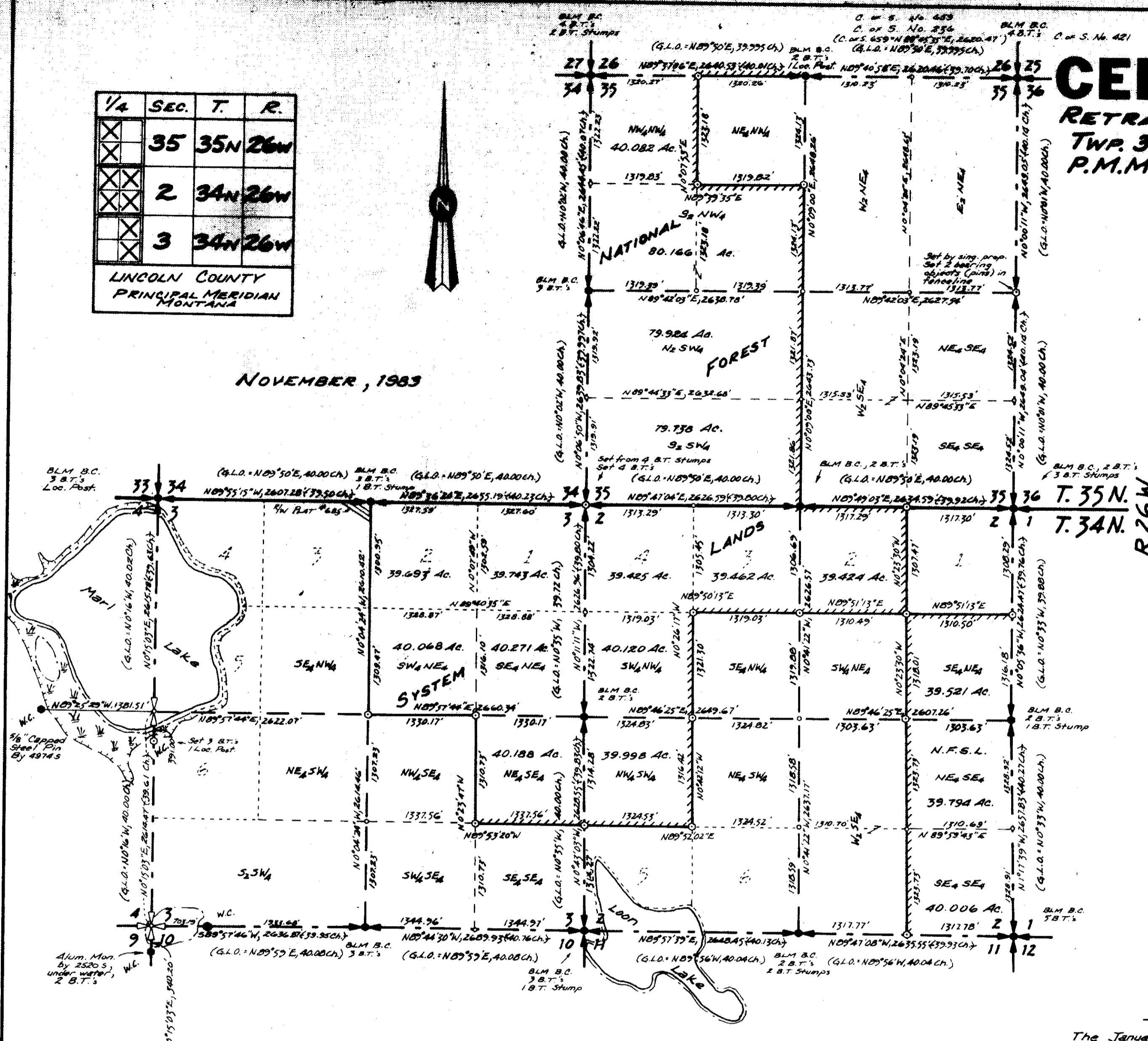

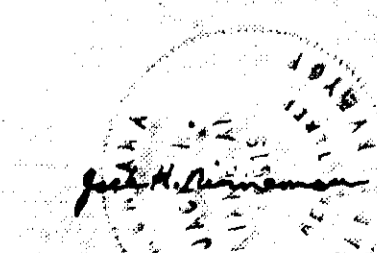
