NOTE: According to deed book M14 page 813, Lincoln County Records, F. W. Fierce conveyed tract 102 to Louis and Harry Burrell in November, 1965 "excepting therefrom all that part of the above described tract which lies north of U.S. Highway No. 2 and lying between said highway and Kootenai River and that portion lying north and west of Cedar Craek." Certificate of Survey No. 3. 348 and 529 do not define the creek in its true location and actually includes lands northwesterly of Cedar Creek in the conveyance to the buyer of the tract to shown on Certificate of Survey. Number '529, contrary to the intent of that instrument above mentioned deed book M14 page 813. This certificate was prepared to correctly define the channell of Cedar Creek as it now is and was in June, 1977. and to correctly show the bearings and distances along the approximate mid-channel of said creek.

PAVENFORT TO TOTTEN, TO RECOME PART OF A PARCEL THAT HAS NO SANITARY RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED ON IT AND THAT NO STRUCTURES REQUIRING WATER OR SEWAGE WILL BE ERECTED ON THE ADDITIONAL ACQUIRED PARCEL.
