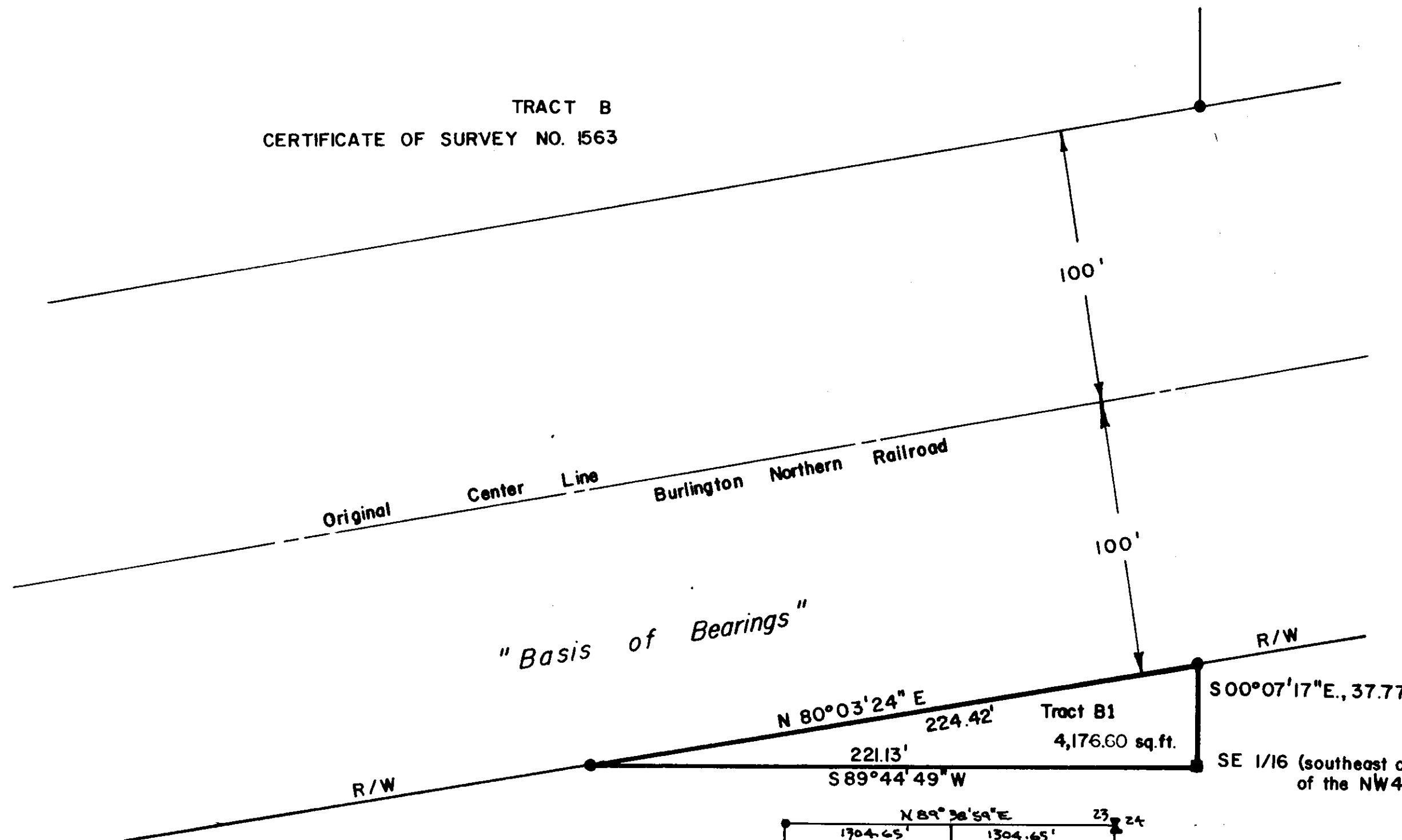

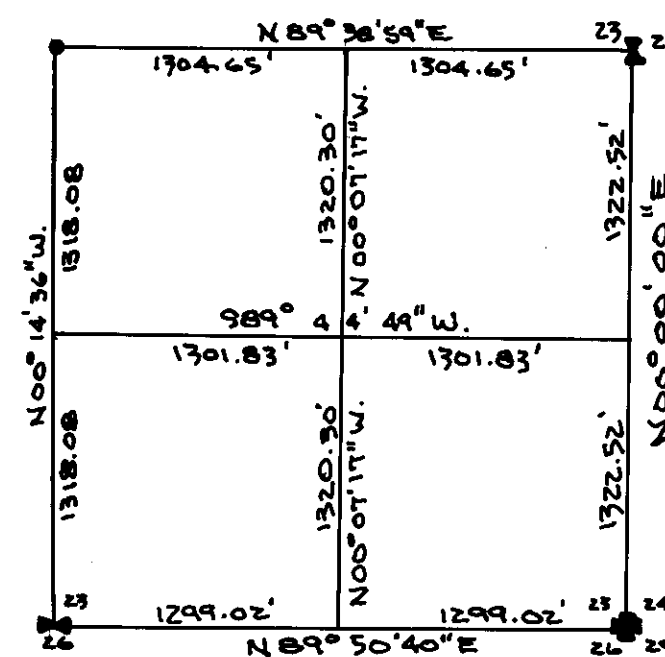

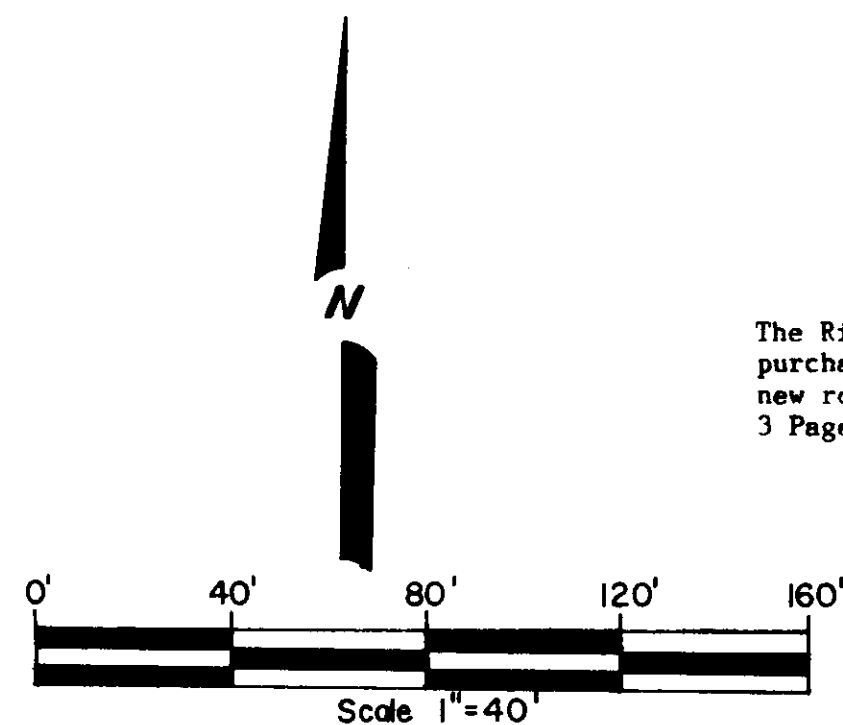


LEGEND

The Right-of-way for the Burlington Northern Railway was established using the maps of the line purchased from their Engineering Section. Said maps show a re-alignment and the position of the new road as compared to the original design. The deeds for this section is found in Tract Book 3 Page 330. The position of the track was established using found railroad survey points.

Beginning at the Southeast 1/16 corner, being the Southeast corner of the northwest 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of said section 23, further being a set 5/8"x24" rebar with 1 1/2" aluminium cap; Thence S89°44'49"W on and along the south boundary of said northwest 1/4 a distance of 221.13 feet to a point on the south right-of-way of the Burlington Northern Railroad; Thence N80°03'24"E on and along said south right-of-way a distance of 224.42 feet to a point on the east boundary of said northwest 1/4; Thence S00°07'17"E on and along said east boundary a distance of 37.77 feet to the Southeast 1/16 corner. Said parcel of land containing 4,176.60 square feet.
