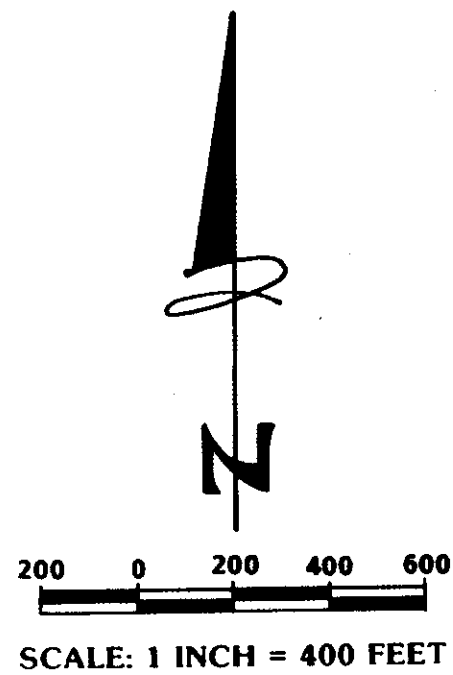

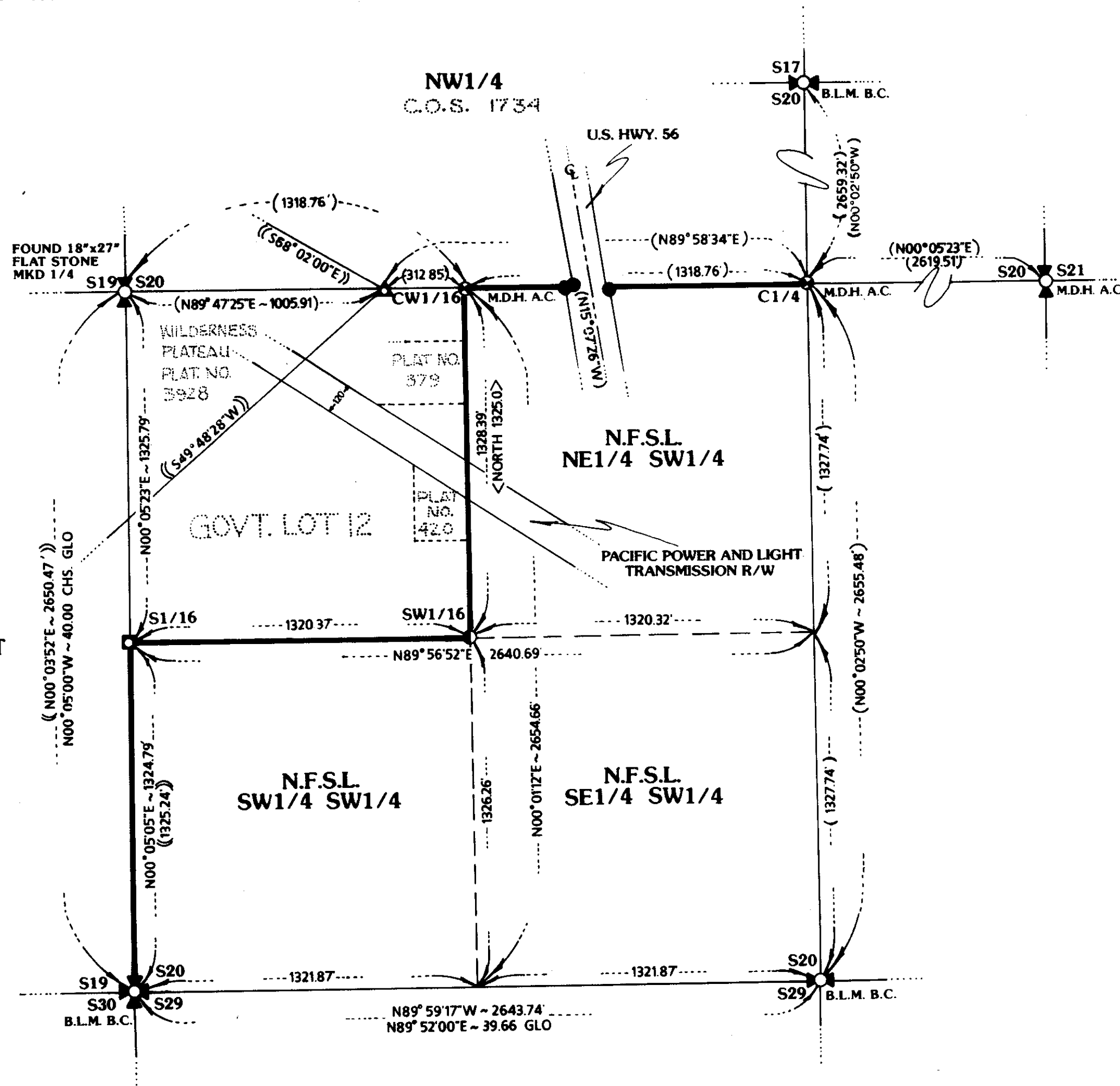

This survey was made at my request for National Forest management purposes.

LEGEND

- Found a B.L.M. 2 1/2" diameter iron post monument with a 3 1/4" diameter brass cap except for the W1/4 Section 20 as noted.
- Found a M.D.H. 3 1/4" diameter aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" diameter aluminum cap per C.O.S. No. 1734.
- Found a M.D.H. R/W monument, a 5/8" diameter rebar with a 2" diameter aluminum cap per C.O.S. No. 1734.
- Set a 3/4" diameter aluminum rod with a 3 1/4" diameter aluminum cap marked 7322LS.
- Found a 5/8" diameter rebar with a yellow plastic cap, marked JHN 4661S. Accepted corner as the S 1/16th and in its exact position, set a 3/4" diameter x 30" long aluminum post with a 3 1/4" diameter cap marked 7322LS.
- Found a 5/8" diameter rebar per Tract A as shown on C.O.S. No. 1734 and P.F. No. 3928.
- Record per Wilderness Plateau Subdivision, P.F. No. 3928, J.H. Ninneman, 4661S
- Record per Plat No's. 379, 420 and 522
- Record per Certificate of Survey No. 1734 by R.S. Custer, 3325S.
- National Forest Boundary - marked and posted to U.S.F.S. Region One Standards.

METHOD OF SURVEY

A one second Total Station and Electronic Data Collector was used with conventional closed traverse procedures to tie original controlling corners. Offsets to true line were computed for marking and posting the property lines. The location of the monuments set this survey meets the positional tolerance standard referenced in the USDA, Forest Service, Region One, Cadastral Contract Specifications manual, dated March 1987.

BASIS OF BEARING

Per Certificate of Survey No. 1734 along the westerly right-of-way limit of U.S. Highway No. 56 which bears N15°07' 26"W.

PURPOSE OF SURVEY

The purpose of this survey is to locate upon the ground the title lines of record between private lands and National Forest Systems Lands. No division of land is hereby created. Project Name: Wilderness Plateau Date of Survey: April-May 1990.
