### TRACT A


A PORTION OF THE S1/2 SW1/4, SECTION 11, T.36N.,R.27W.,P.M.M., LINCOLN COUNTY, MONTANA, AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE CORNER COMMON TO SECTIONS 10, 11, 14 AND 15, T.36N.,R.27W.,P.M.M.; THENCE N75°11'28"E, 1563.87 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE S76°51'20"W, 149.11 FEET TO THE EAST-ERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY OF US HIGHWAY #93; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID RIGHT-OF-WAY BOUNDARY ALONG A CURVE TO THE RIGHT WITH A RADIUS OF 5666.81 FEET AND A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 2°01'07" FOR A DISTANCE OF 199.67 FEET; THENCE N76°24'08"E, 132.01 FEET; THENCE S13°15'08"E, 199.99 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 0.65 ACRES, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO ALL EASEMENTS, RESERVATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS, APPARENT OR OF RECORD.




