PURPOSE OF SURVEY

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO LOCATE UPON THE GROUND THE TITLE LINES OF RECORD BETWEEN PRIVATELY OWNED LAND AND NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS, AND NO DIVISION OF LANDS IS HEREBY CREATED.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS DEFINED HEREON: THE E 1/2 AND NW 1/4 OF THE NE 1/4, AND THE E 1/2 AND NW 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4, AND THE W 1/2 OF THE SW 1/4, AND THE SW 1/4 AND NE 1/4 OF THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 10, T28N, R30W, P.M. MT., LESS THAT PART OF SECTION 10 CONTAINED WITHIN THE U.S. HIGHWAY 2 RIGHT-OF-WAY.

SURVEY METHOD

THIS SURVEY WAS ACCOMPLISHED USING A TOTAL STATION TRAVERSE, AUGUST 1993-NOVEMBER 1993.

BASIS OF BEARING

BEARINGS ARE BASED ON SOLAR OBSERVATION

NOTES

1. THE LINES MARKED ARE TO NATIONAL FOREST STANDARDS WITH 6 FOOT STEEL POSTS, DECALS, AND BLAZED TREES.
2. FIELD NOTES AND COMPUTATIONS ARE FILED IN THE FOREST SERVICE OFFICE, KOOTENAI NATIONAL FOREST. CORNER RECORDATION FORMS ARE FILED IN THE COUNTY RECORDER'S OFFICE OF THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY.
3. THE PRECISION OF THE MEASURING SYSTEM USED PROVIDES THAT THE LOCATION OF ALL MONUMENTS SET OR FOUND MEET FOREST SERVICE POSITIONAL TOLERANCE STANDARDS AS SPECIFIED.

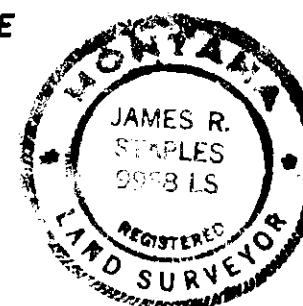
