

DESCRIPTION OF ROADWAY "A"

A strip of land, 60.00 feet wide, the centerline of which is described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike located on the north line of Section 24, Twp. 31 N, R. 34 W, P.M.M., driven in flush with the pavement, marking the approximate centerline of an existing roadway known as Garrison Loop Road, from which bears N 89°59732" W 1717.24 feet from a 3 1/4 inch dia. brass cap marking the section corner common to Sections 18, 13, 24, and 19 of Twp. 31 N, R. 34 W, P.M.M.; thence, from said point of beginning along the approximate centerline of said existing roadway, the following (14) courses; S 30°51'34" E 8.31 feet; thence, on the arc of a curve to the right; having a radius of 400.08 feet, an arc length of 216.39 feet, turning through a delta angle of 30°59'19"; thence, S 00°07'45" W 162.27 feet; thence, on the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of 110.05 feet, an arc length of 222.81 feet, turning through a delta angle of 116°00'12"; thence, N 64°07'34" E 138.44 feet; thence, on the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of 221.72 feet, as arc length of 178.59 feet, turning through a delta angle of 46°09'06"; thence, S 69°43'21" E 73.67 feet; thence; on the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of 440.73 feet, an arc length of 293.44 feet, turning through a delta angle of 38°08'51"; thence, N 72°07'48" E 94.85 feet; thence, on the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of 2213.74 feet, an arc length of 263.53 feet, turning through a delta angle of 06°49'14"; thence, N 78°57'02" E 80.71 feet; thence, on the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of 2205.56 feet, an arc length of 266.89 feet, turning through a delta angle of 06°56'00"; thence, N 72°01'02" E 105.17 feet; thence, on the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of 351.85 feet, an arc length of 62.24 feet, turning through a delta angle of 10°08'07", to a railroad spike set flush with the pavement, located on the east line of said Section 24, from which bears S 00°00'23" W 213.68 feet to a 3 1/4 inch dia. brass cap marking the section corner common to Sections 18, 13, 24, and 19 of Twp. 31 N, R. 34 W, P.M.M., the side lines of the aforementioned strip of land to be shortened or lengthened to terminate at the above described north line and east line of said Section 24.

Said tract of land contains 2.985 acres, more or less, excepting therefrom a strip of land described per C. of S. No. 1378, lying on the westerly side of the aforedescribed centerline, containing .094 acres, all as shown hereon.

DESCRIPTION OF ROADWAY "B"

A strip of land, 60.00 feet wide, the centerline of which is described as follows: Beginning at a railroad spike located on the east line of Section 24, Twp. 31 N, R. 34 W, P.M.M., driven in flush County Clerk and recorder umming with the pavement, marking the approximate centerline of an existing roadway known as Iron Creek Road, from which bears S 00°00'23" W 562.90 feet from a 3 1/4 inch dia. brass cap marking the section corner common to Sections 18, 13, 24, and 19 of Twp. 31 N, R. 34 W, P.M.M.; thence, from said point of beginning TAX CERTIFICATION along the approximate centerline of an existing roadway, the following (5) courses; S 76°57'29" W 21.34 feet; thence, on the I hereby certify that all real property taxes and special arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of 174.99 feet, an assessments assessed and levied on the land to be divided have been paid, Dated this $\frac{27\%}{27\%}$ day of $\frac{1992}{27\%}$. arc length of 182.95 feet, turning through a delta angle of 59°54'03"; thence, S 17°03'26" E 27.01 feet; thence, on the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of 100.00 feet, an arc 1 seiter length of 176.76 feet, turning through a delta angle of Treasurer, Lincoln County, Montana 101°16'21"; thence, S 84°12'55" E 71.33 feet to a railroad spike set flush with the pavement, located on the east line of said Section 24, from which bears S 00°00'23" W feet to a 3 1/4 inch dia. brass cap marking the section corner common to LEGAL AND PHYSICAL ACCESS Sections 18, 13, 24, and 19 of Twp. 31 N, R. 34 W, P.M.M., the side lines of the aforementioned strip of land to be shortened I hereby certify that physical access to all lots within or lengthened to terminate at the above described east line of this suvdivision is provided by said Section 24. The driving surface is approximately _____ feet wide. Said tract of land contains .66 acres, more or less.

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
