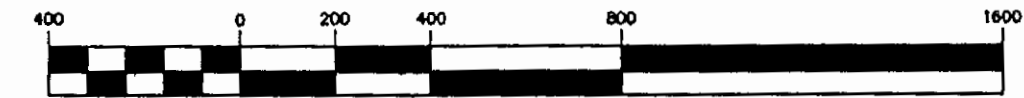

PURPOSE OF SURVEY:

The purpose of this survey is to retrace, set corners and mark the boundaries of an existing record parcel, distinguishing between Champion Realty Corporation (Florida) land and public lands pursuant to Section 76-3-401, M.C.A., as shown hereon.

SURVEY HISTORY:

Original G.L.O. survey by Allen Benedict in 1903.

Retracement of the North Half of the East line during the survey of HES 741 by E.R. Johnson in 1917.

Remonumentation by B.L.M. in 1967.

Retracement of South line by J.T. Shaw in 1975 as per Certificate of Survey No. 195.

Retracement of the North Half of the East line by M. Lauteren in 1978 as per Certificate of Survey No. 535A.

Section Breakdown by USFS (Hill) November, 1982 as per Certificate of Survey No. 1083.

Retracement of Certificate of Survey No. 1287 by Ninneman Engineering (West Half) as per Certificate of Survey No. 1287.

METHOD OF SURVEY:

THEODOLITE-EDM TRAVERSE - Adjustment by STARNET (Least Square)

BASIS OF BEARING:

All bearings are based upon those bearings reported on Certificate of Survey No. 195 obtained from appropriate ties thereto and Certificate of Survey No. 1083 and Certificate of Survey No. 1287 reported to bear S 89°36'52" E.

NOTE:

During the course of this survey we determined the position of several USFS monuments and compared them to record positions. These positions were generated from Certificate of Survey No. 1083. Some inconsistency was noted and reported to USFS. After careful analysis, the USFS decided to accept the field locations and honor the true boundary lines as marked and posted previously. These variances were also verified on Certificate of Survey No. 1287.
