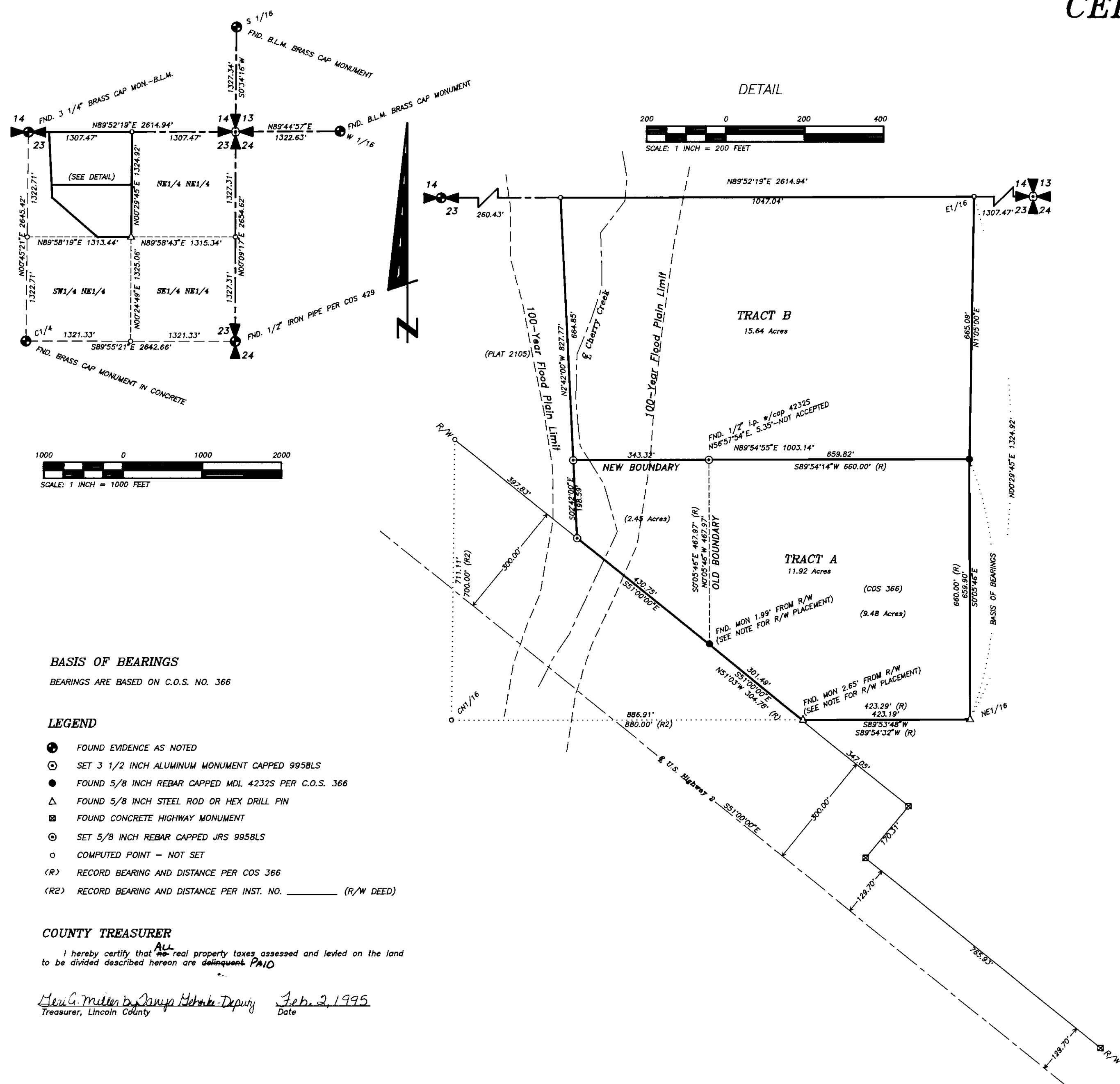

 A tract of land in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW1/4 NE1/4) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Thirty (30) North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, of the Principal Meridian Montana, Lincoln County, Montana; more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of the NW1/4 of the NE1/4; thence, S1°05'00"W, 665.09 feet to a 1/2" iron pipe with plastic cap marked MDL 4232S, marking the northeast corner of Certificate of Survey No. 366 and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence, S0°05'46"E, 659.90 feet to a 5/8" rebar marking the southeast corner of Certificate of Survey No. 366; thence, S89°53'48"W, 423.19 feet to the easterly right of way of U.S. Highway 2 marked by a hex drill pin; thence, along the easterly right of way, N5°10'28"W, 304.80 feet to a 1/2" iron pipe with plastic cap marked MDL 4232S, marking the southwest corner of Certificate of Survey No. 366; thence, N47°49'53"W, 453.92 feet to the centerline of Cherry Creek, thence, N2°42'00"W, 162.92 feet; thence, N89°54'55"E, 343.32; thence, N89°54'55"E, 659.82 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; encompassing an area of 11.92 acres.
