### DESCRIPTION OF TRACT "A"

Kurtz Boundary Adjustment

An irregular tract of land in Lincoln County, Montana, being a part of C. of S. No. 1545 in Section 35 and 36, both of Twp. 32 N., R. 34 W., P.M.M., containing Tract 1 being .754 acres, more or less, and Parcel "B" being .662 acres, more or less, for a total area of 1.416 acres, more or less, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 2 1/2 inch dia. BLM brass cap meander corner on the right bank of the Kootenai River marking the west line of C of. S. No. 305 and 564; **thence**, from said point of beginning N 50°07'54" E 186.10 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S located in the approximate centerline of a 60.00 foot roadway known as River Road; **thence**, N 27°50'54" W 261.59 feet along said approximate centerline to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S; **thence**, continuing along said approximate centerline on the arc of a curve to the left concaved southwesterly 49.00 feet, turning through a delta angle of 05°51'24", having a radius of 480.00 feet and a radial bearing of S 62°09'06" W to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S; **thence**, leaving said centerline S 56°17'42" W 203.55 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S (set this survey) on the meander line of the right bank of the Kootenai River and the west line of Parcel "A" of C. of S. No. 1545; **thence**, S 31°42'27" E 322.91 feet along said meander line to the point of beginning.

The aforescribed Tract "A" contains 1.416 acres, more or less.

### DESCRIPTION OF TRACT "B"

Kurtz Boundary Adjustment

An irregular tract of land in Lincoln County, Montana, in the SE 1/4 of Section 35, Twp. 32 N., R. 34 W., P.M.M., containing 1.540 acres, more or less, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S located at the intersection of the centerline of the River Road and the east line of said Section 35, Twp. 32 N., R. 34 W., P.M.M.; **thence**, on the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 480.00 feet, which radius bears S 56°17'42" W, turning through a central angle of 18°42'53", an arc length of 156.78 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S; **thence**, continuing along said centerline N 52°25'11" W 280.00 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S; **thence**, leaving said centerline S 37°34'35" W 119.33 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S located on the meander line of the right bank of the Kootenai River; **thence**, along said meander line S 39°17'32" E 287.51 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped: KED 4975-S; **thence**, continuing along said meander line S 31°42'27" E 94.83 feet; **thence**, N 56°17'42" E 203.55 feet to the point of beginning.

The aforescribed Tract 2 contains 1.540 acres, more or less.

### PURPOSE OF SURVEY/EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE

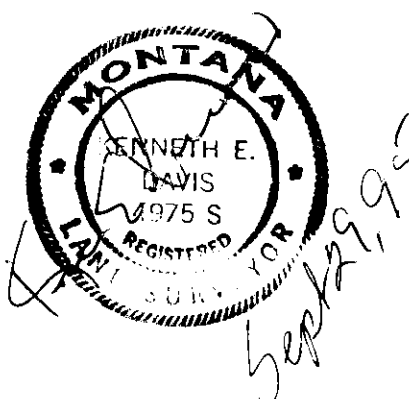

We hereby certify that the purpose for extending the boundaries is to acquire additional land to become part of a parcel that does not have sanitary restrictions imposed provided that no dwelling or structure requiring water or sewage be erected on the additional acquired parcel; therefore, this division of land is exempt from review by the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences pursuant to A.R.M. 16-2.14 (10)-514340 Sub-Chapter 6 Exclusions 16.16.605(2)(a)
