

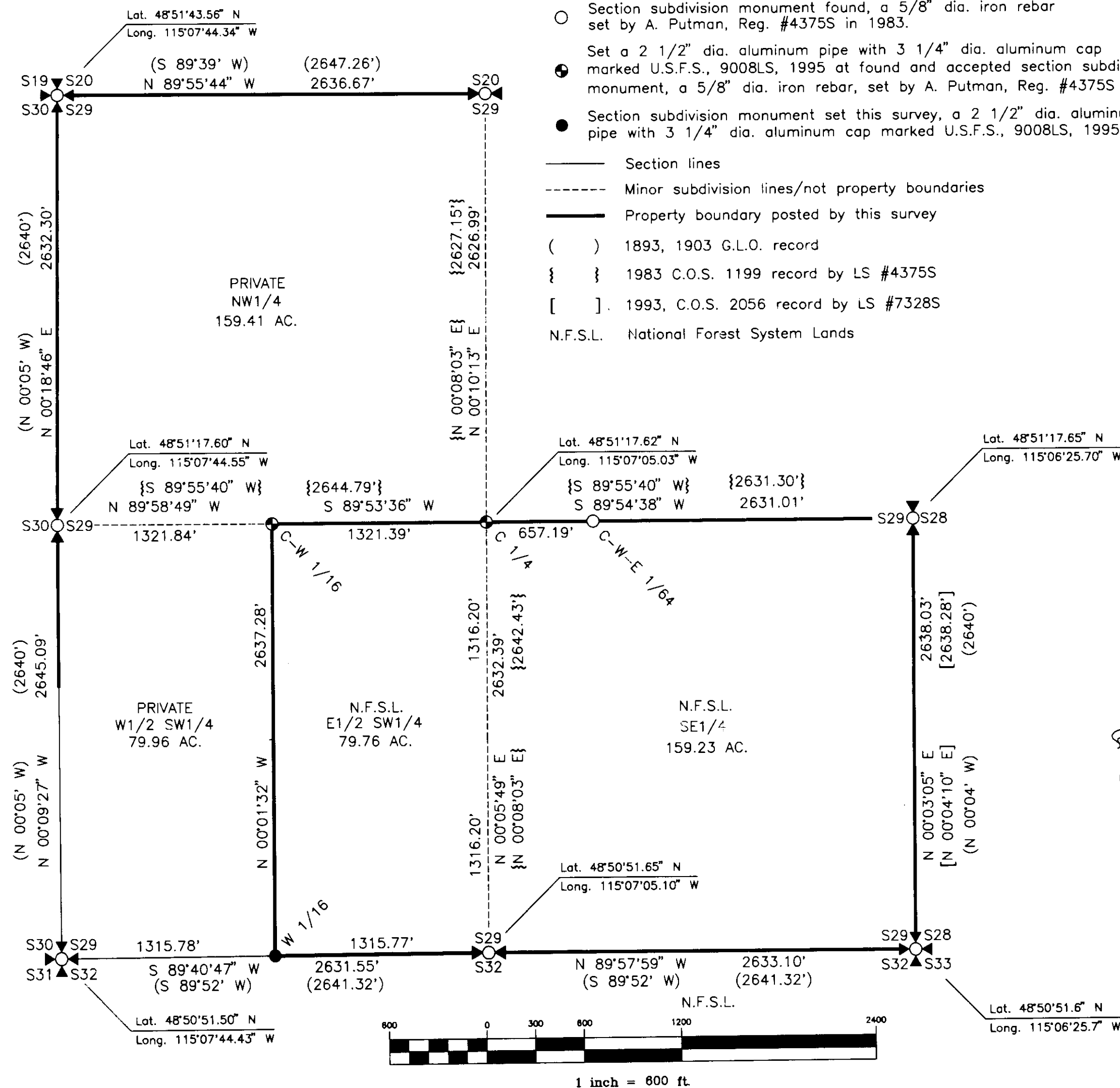

1983, C.O.S. 1199 & 1207, subdivision of section 29 by Albert P. Putnam, Reg. #4375S.
1984, C.O.S. 1275, creates Tract-1 in NE1/4, sec. 29 by Albert P. Putnam, Reg. #4375S.

METHOD OF SURVEY

Control was accomplished using survey grade Global Positioning System receivers, and a constrained Least Squares Adjustment, based on N.G.S. first order control station "Airp" and 2nd order horizontal control station "Eureka". Secondary traverse done with Total Station - EDM.

BASIS OF BEARING

Global Positioning System ties to N.G.S. control stations "Airp" and "Eureka"
N.A.D. 83/International Feet.
