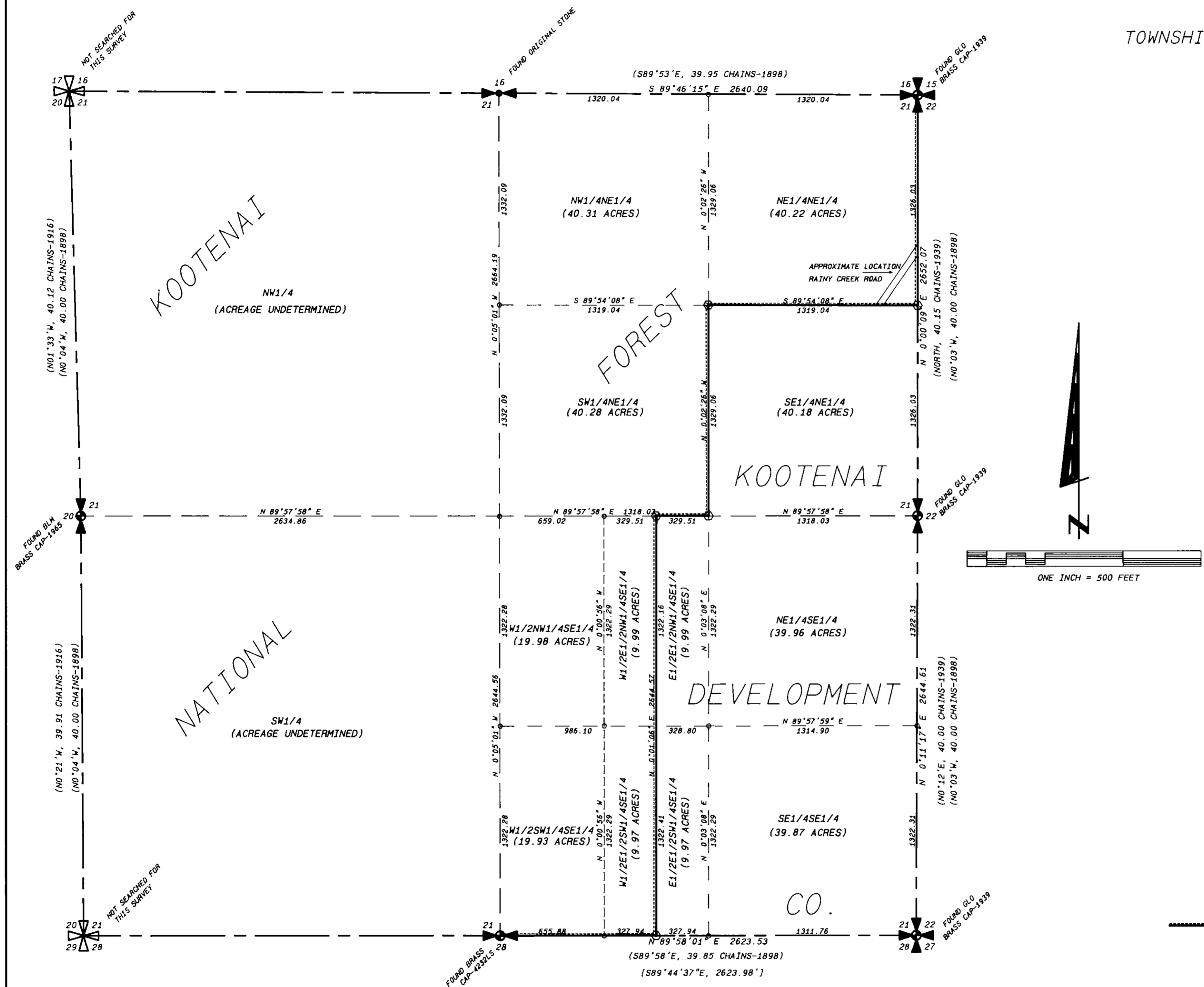

 THIS SURVEY WAS ACCOMPLISHED USING A TOTAL STATION TRAVERSE JUNE 1995-JULY 1995.

BASIS OF BEARINGS
 BEARINGS BASED ON A SOLAR OBSERVATION.

- NOTES**
1. THE LINES MARKED ARE TO NATIONAL FOREST STANDARDS WITH 6 FOOT STEEL POSTS, DECALS, AND BLAZED TREES.
 2. FIELD NOTES AND COMPUTATIONS ARE FILED IN THE FOREST SERVICE OFFICE, KOOTENAI NATIONAL FOREST. CORNER RECORDATION FORMS ARE FILED IN THE COUNTY RECORDER'S OFFICE OF LINCOLN COUNTY.
 3. THE PRECISION OF THE MEASURING SYSTEM USED PROVIDES THAT THE LOCATION OF ALL MONUMENTS SET OR FOUND MEET FOREST SERVICE POSITIONAL TOLERANCE STANDARDS AS SPECIFIED.
 4. THIS PROJECT WAS CONDUCTED AS A COOPERATIVE CONTRACT BETWEEN MARK OWENS LOGGING INC., AND THE KOOTENAI NATIONAL FOREST.
