

Original survey of the north line of T. 26 N., R. 30 W., by Burton S. Adams 1900.

PURPOSE OF SURVEY

The purpose of this survey is to retrace and mark the boundaries of the south line of the N 1/2, NW 1/4 and the N 1/2, NE 1/4 of a record parcel of land distinguishing between National Forest System lands and Private lands and no division of land is hereby created. This survey was completed as a co-op between the U.S. Forest Service, Plum Creek Timber Inc. and Private.

BASIS OF BEARING

Basis of bearing was per solar observation taken near the NW section corner of section 2. The northerly section line was rotated to bearing.

METHOD OF SURVEY

This survey was compiled by utilizing conventional EDM traverse and intersection method.
