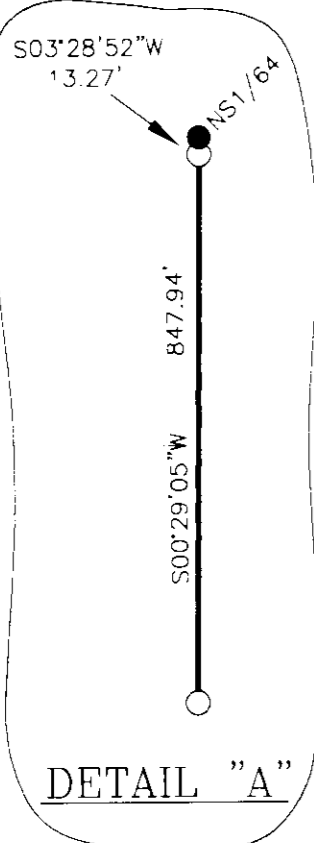
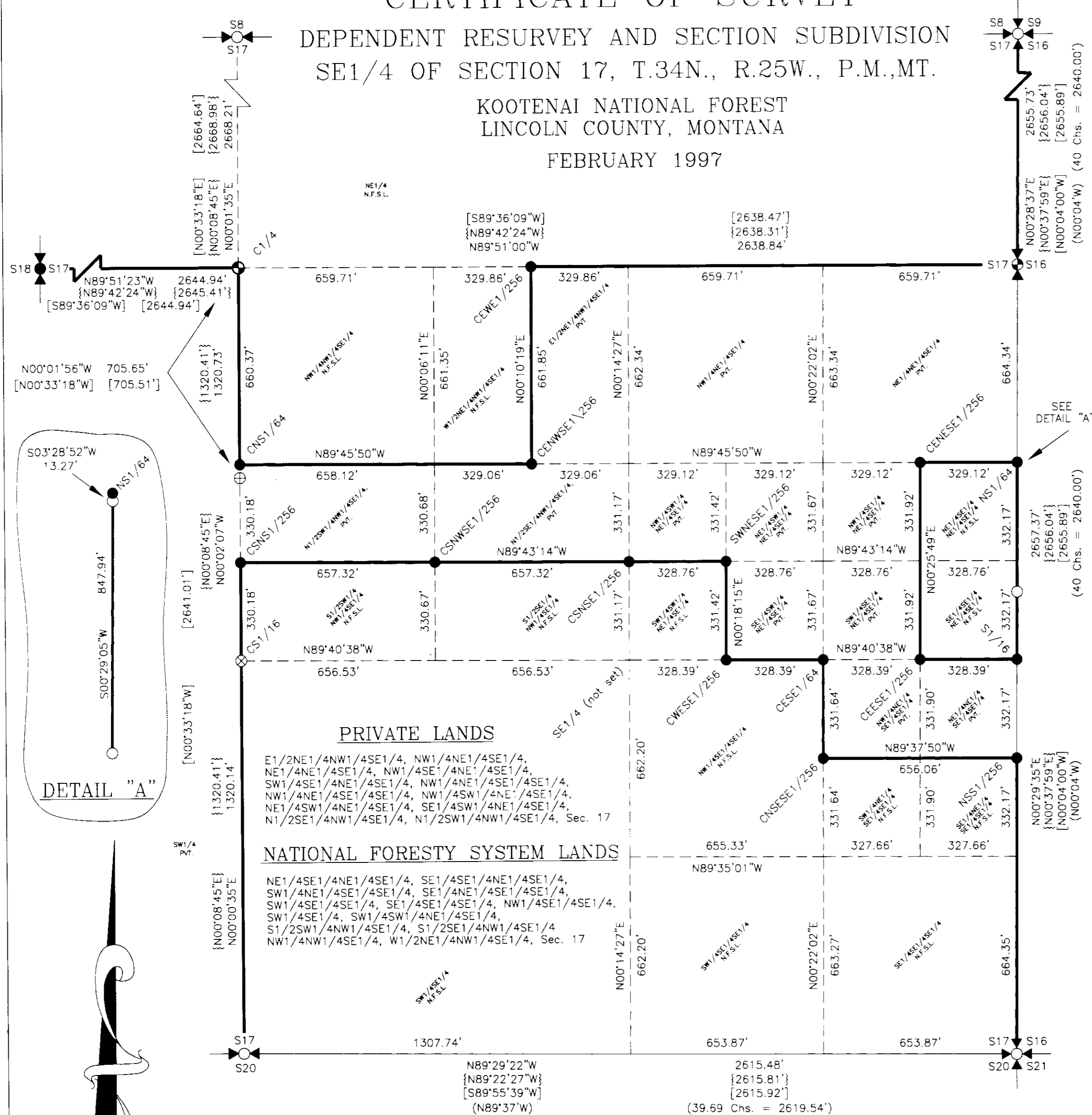

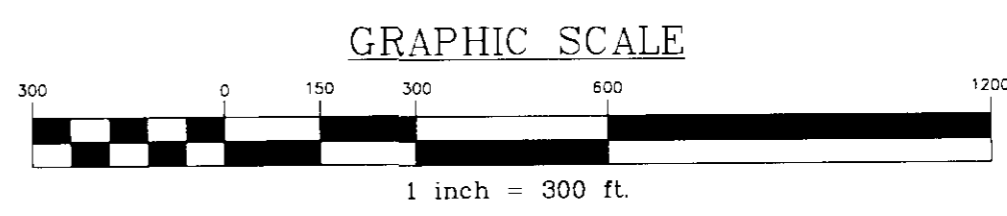

METHOD OF SURVEY

A one second, total station and data collector was used with closed traverse procedures to the original controlling corners. The location of the monuments, set this survey meet the positional tolerance standard referenced in the U.S.D.A. Forest Service, Region One, Cadastral Contract Specification Manual, dated 1987.

Bearing based on solar observation from C.O.S. 1149, section line between S20 & 29
