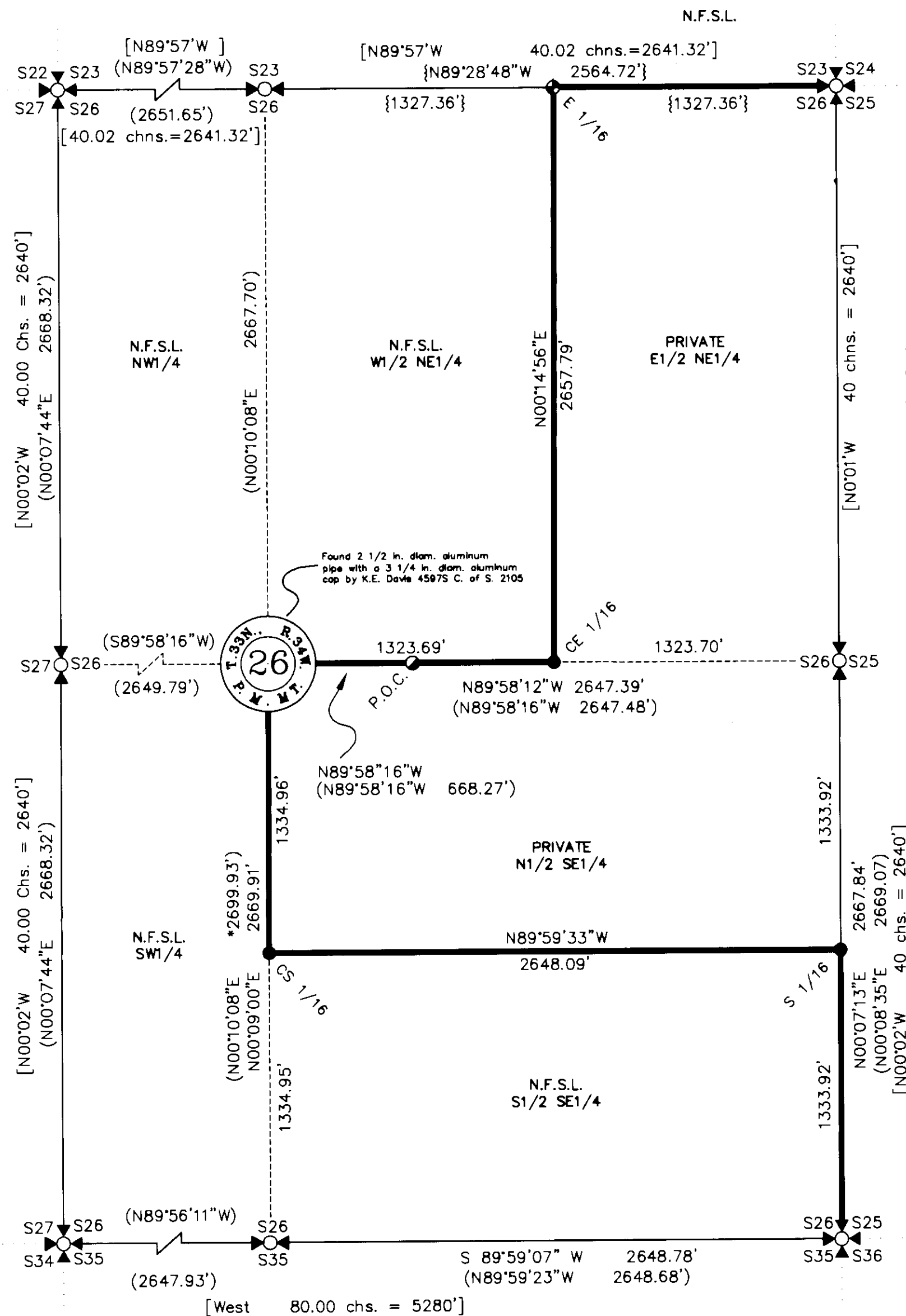

**METHOD OF SURVEY**

A one second, total station and data collector was used with closed traverse procedures to the original controlling corners. The location of the monuments set this survey meet the positional tolerance standard referenced in the U.S.D.A. Forest Service, Region One, Cadastral Contract Specification Manual, dated 1987.

**BASIS OF BEARING**

Rotated to record bearing between the center 1/4 of section 26 and a 5/8 in. diam. rebar, P.O.C. on the mid (east / west) section line as reported on C.O.S. 2105 by K. E. Davis, 4975 Point bears S89°58'16"E, 668.27' from C 1/4 of section.
