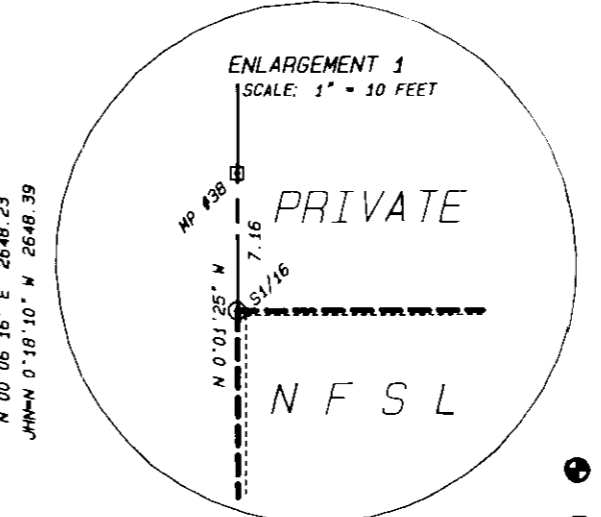
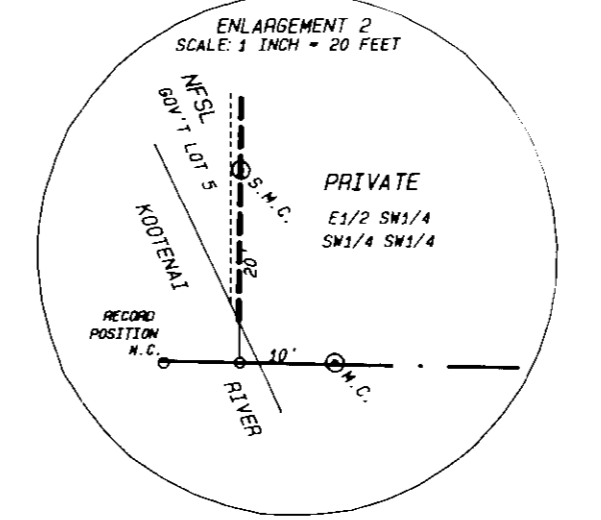


NOTE
 The northwest corner of Section 17 was established at a proportional distance from Milepost #36 on line between found milepost monuments. The west quarter corner of Section 17 was established by proportioning the record distances along the state line (for lack of better evidence assuming 20.00 chain distances between Government Lot corners) and moving cardinal east or west to position between found State line monuments. The south line of the North Half of "Government Lot 4" was established by computing a weighted mean bearing between the south section line and the north line of "Government Lot 4". Note-Government Lot 4 was extinguished by the Supplemental Plat dated Nov. 5, 1915 and replaced by Government Lot 5, the E1/2 N1/2 SW1/4 SW1/4, and the E1/2 SW1/4 SW1/4.

SURVEY METHOD
 THIS SURVEY WAS ACCOMPLISHED USING A COMBINATION OF GPS CONTROL AND TOTAL STATION TRAVERSE, USING LEICA MODELS 605 & 805.

BASIS OF BEARINGS
 BEARINGS ARE BASED ON FOREST SERVICE G.P.S., NGS CONTROL, AND A USER DEFINED TRANSVERSE MERCATOR COORDINATE SYSTEM WITH A CENTRAL MERIDIAN AT LATITUDE 48°00'00" N AND LONGITUDE 116°00'20" W. SCALE FACTOR 1.000107425486. REFER TO FOREST SERVICE SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 20, T33N, R34W, P.M.M.

NOTES
 1. THE LINES MARKED ARE TO NATIONAL FOREST STANDARDS WITH 6 FOOT STEEL POSTS, DECALS AND BLAZED TREES.

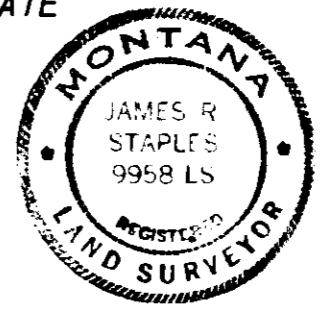
