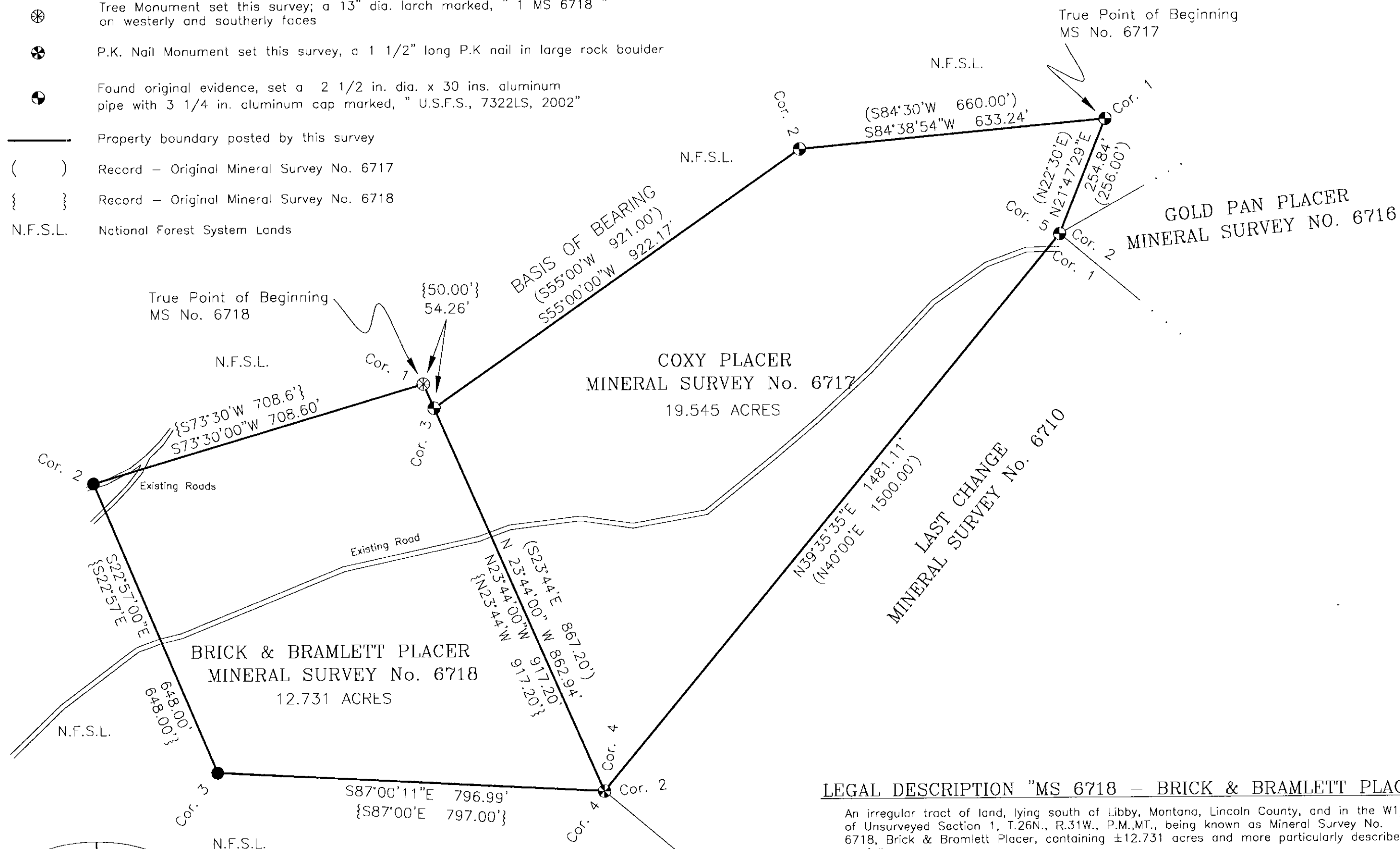

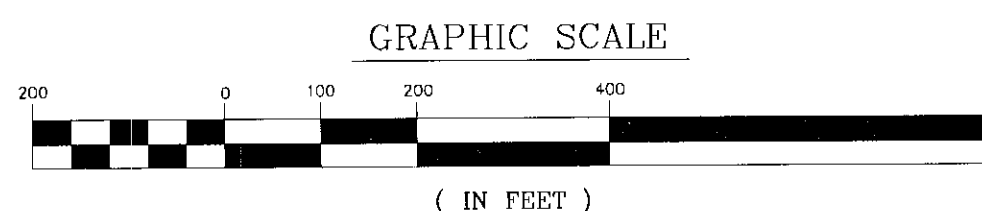
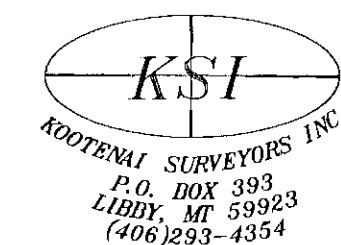
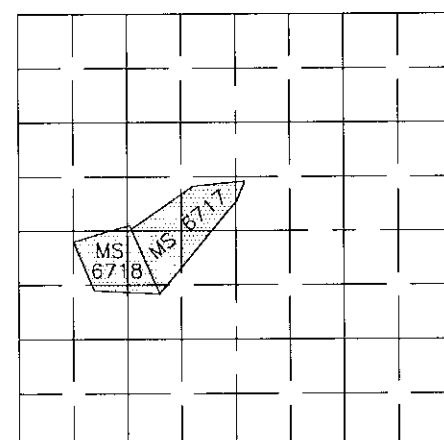

LEGAL DESCRIPTION "MS 6717 - COXY PLACER"

An irregular tract of land, lying south of Libby, Montana, Lincoln County, and in the W1/2, Unserved Section 1, T.26N., R.31W., P.M.,MT., being known as Mineral Survey No. 6717, "Coxy Placer", containing ±19.545 acres and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at Corner 1, M.S. 6717, a 2 1/2 inch diameter aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4 inch aluminum cap marked, "T26N R31W S1, COR 1, MS 6717, 7322LS, 2002" and the True Point of Beginning; Thence S84°38'54"W, 633.24 feet, along the northerly boundary of said M.S. 6717, to a 2 1/2 inch diameter aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4 inch diameter aluminum cap marked, "T26N R31W S1, COR 2, MS 6717, 7322LS, 2002"; Thence S55°00'00"W, 922.17 feet, along the northwesterly boundary of said placer, intersecting the easterly boundary of M.S. 6718, a 2 1/4 inch diameter aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4 inch diameter aluminum cap marked, "T26N R31W S1, COR 3 MS 6717, 7322LS, 2002"; Thence S23°44'00"E, 862.94 feet, along the common boundary line between M.S. No. 6717 and M.S. No. 6718, to a common corner, Corner No. 4, M.S. 6717 and M.S. 6718, and Corner No. 2, M.S. 6710, a 1 1/2 inch long P.K. nail set in a large rock boulder; Thence N39°35'35"E, 1481.11 feet, along the southeasterly boundary of said placer, to a 2 1/2 inch diameter aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4 inch diameter aluminum cap marked, "T26N R31W S1, COR 5 MS 6717, COR 1 MS 6710, COR 1 MS 6716, 7322LS, 2002"; Thence N21°47'29"E, 254.84 feet, along the southeasterly boundary of said placer, to the True Point of Beginning, containing a total of ±19.545 acres. Subject to and together with all appurtenant easements of record.

A total station and data collector was used with closed traverse procedures to tie previously set original corners.
