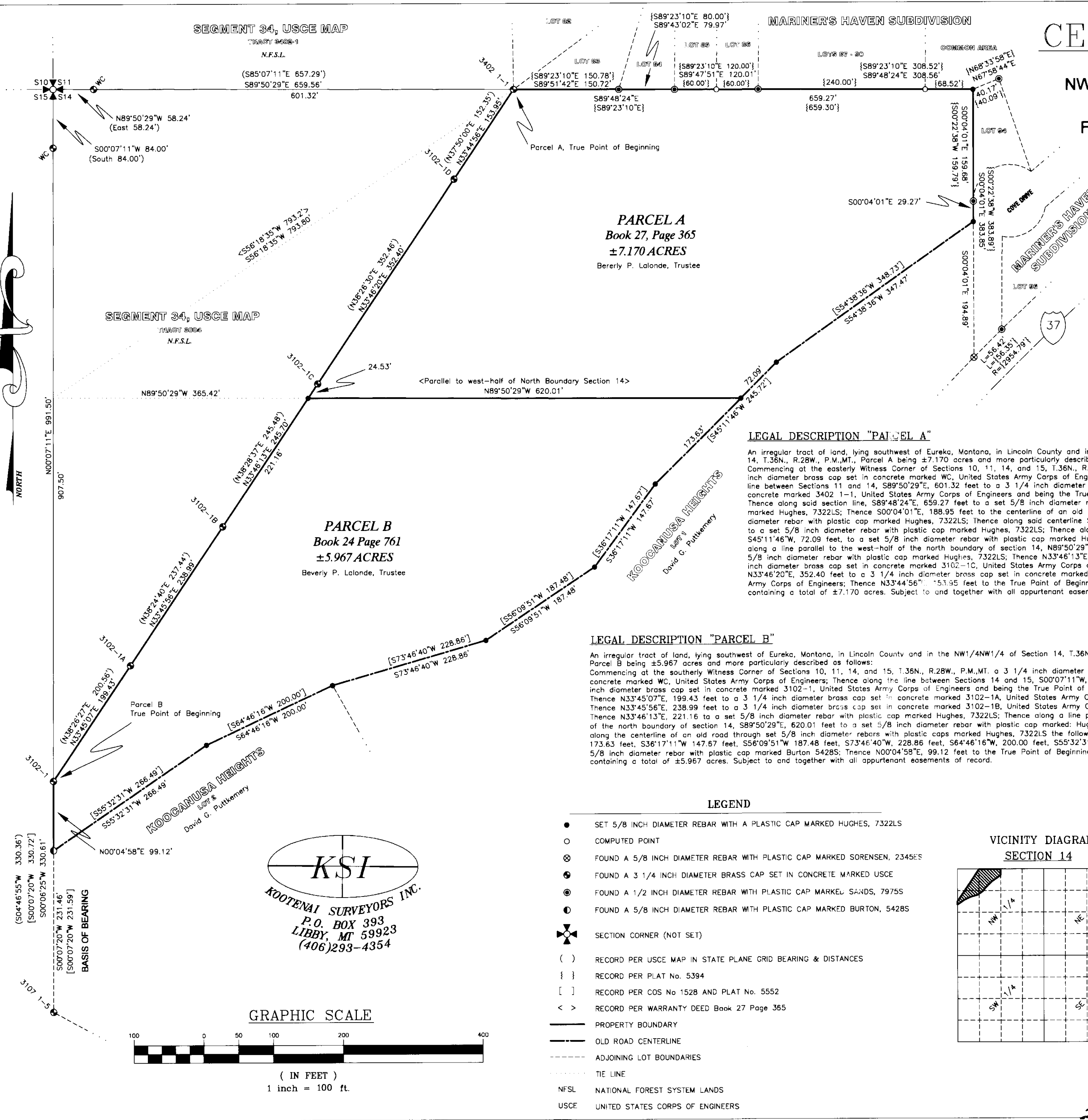

LEGAL DESCRIPTION "PARCEL A"

An irregular tract of land, lying southwest of Eureka, Montana, in Lincoln County and in the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 14, T.36N., R.28W., P.M.,MT., Parcel A being ±7.170 acres and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the easterly Witness Corner of Sections 10, 11, 14, and 15, T.36N., R.28W., P.M.,MT. a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked WC, United States Army Corps of Engineers; Thence along the line between Sections 11 and 14, S89°50'29"E, 601.32 feet to a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked 3102-1, United States Army Corps of Engineers and being the True Point of Beginning; Thence along said section line, S89°48'24"E, 659.27 feet to a set 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked Hughes, 7322LS; Thence S00°04'01"E, 188.95 feet to the centerline of an old road to a set 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked Hughes, 7322LS; Thence along said centerline, S54°38'36"W, 347.47 feet to a set 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked Hughes, 7322LS; Thence along said centerline, S45°11'46"W, 72.09 feet, to a set 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked Hughes, 7322LS; Thence along a line parallel to the west-half of the north boundary of section 14, N89°50'29"W, 620.01 feet to a set 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked Hughes, 7322LS; Thence N33°46'13"E, 24.53 feet to a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked 3102-1C, United States Army Corps of Engineers; Thence N33°46'20"E, 352.40 feet to a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked 3102-1D, United States Army Corps of Engineers; Thence N33°44'56"E, 153.95 feet to the True Point of Beginning for Parcel A, containing a total of ±7.170 acres. 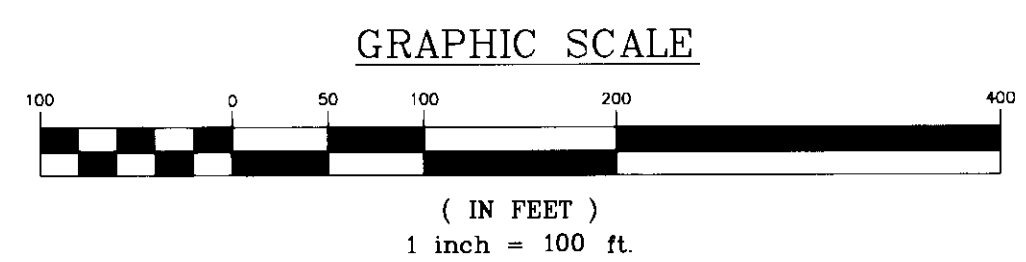
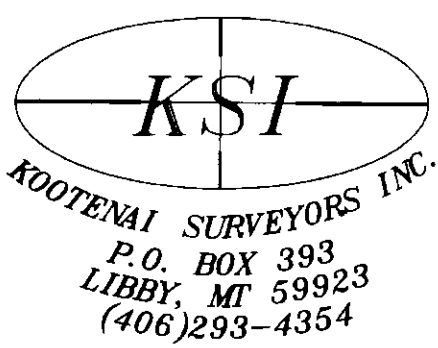
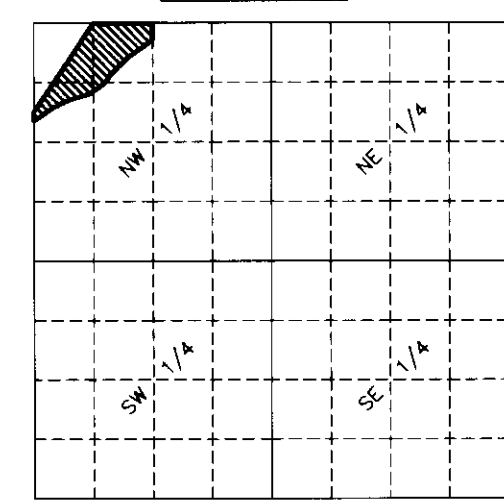

An irregular tract of land, lying southwest of Eureka, Montana, in Lincoln County and in the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 14, T.36N., R.28W., P.M.,MT., Parcel B being ±5.967 acres and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the southerly Witness Corner of Sections 10, 11, 14, and 15, T.36N., R.28W., P.M.,MT. a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked WC, United States Army Corps of Engineers; Thence along the line between Sections 14 and 15, S00°07'11"W, 907.50 feet to a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked 3102-1, United States Army Corps of Engineers and being the True Point of Beginning; Thence N33°45'07"E, 199.43 feet to a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked 3102-1A, United States Army Corps of Engineers; Thence N33°45'56"E, 238.99 feet to a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked 3102-1B, United States Army Corps of Engineers; Thence N33°46'13"E, 221.16 feet to a set 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked Hughes, 7322LS; Thence along a line parallel to the west-half of the north boundary of section 14, S89°50'29"E, 620.01 feet to a set 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked Hughes, 7322LS; Thence along the centerline of an old road through set 5/8 inch diameter rebars with plastic caps marked Hughes, 7322LS the following course: S45°11'46"W, 173.63 feet, S36°17'11"W, 147.67 feet, S56°09'51"W, 187.48 feet, S73°46'40"W, 228.86 feet, S64°46'16"W, 200.00 feet, S55°32'31"W, 266.49 feet to a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked Burton 5428S; Thence N00°04'58"E, 99.12 feet to the True Point of Beginning for Parcel B, containing a total of ±5.967 acres. PURPOSE OF SURVEY

The purpose of this survey is the resurvey of record parcels of land, Parcels A & B, reestablish obliterated corners, and mark property boundaries. Therefore, no division of land is hereby created and is exempt from review as a subdivision pursuant to Section 76-3-404 MCA.

METHOD OF SURVEY

A total station with a data collector was used with closed traverse procedures to tie previously set controlling monuments by Pete Landis, August 5, 2004.

BASIS OF BEARING

The basis of bearing for this survey is S00°07'20"W, as shown on COS 1528 between a 5/8 inch rebar with plastic cap marked Burton, 5428S and a 3 1/4 inch diameter brass cap set in concrete marked 3107 1-5 USCE.
