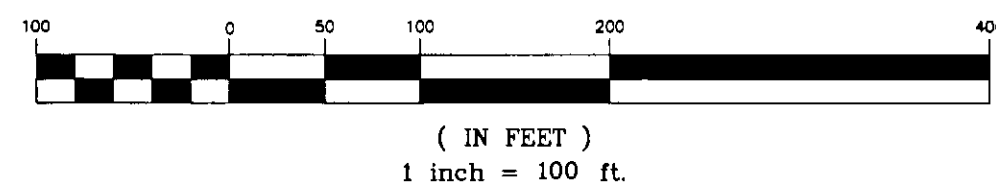

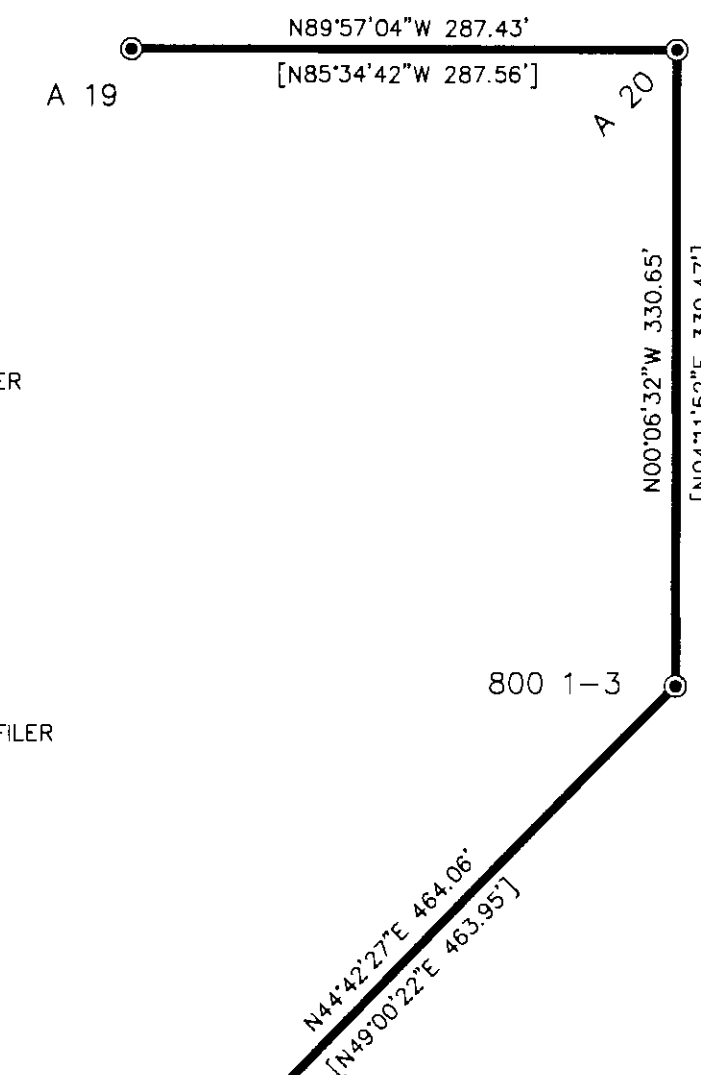
GRAPHIC SCALE

LONGITUDE: 115°17'26.19"W

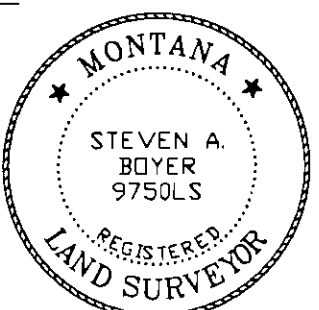
