Thence S89°41'10"W, 688.38 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter uncapped rebar and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, REMAINDER;  
Thence continuing S89°41'10"W, 392.57 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter rebar with plastic cap marked 7322LS and the northeast corner, Parcel "A";

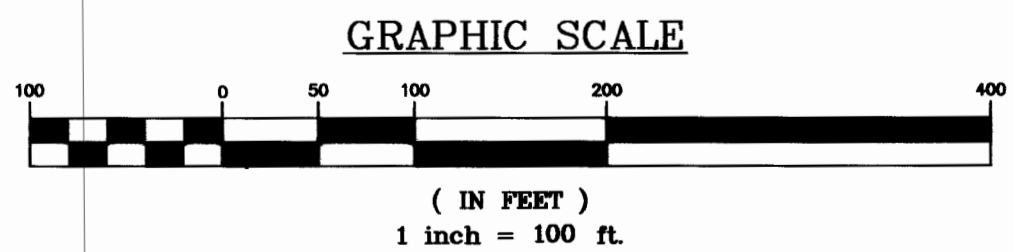

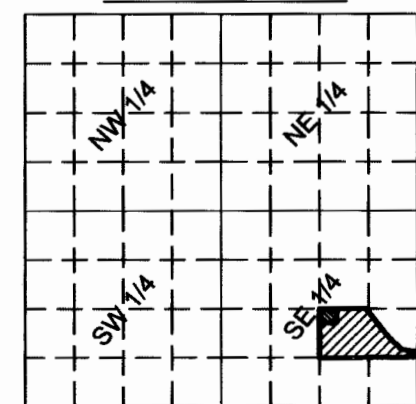
