PURPOSE OF SURVEY

The purpose of this survey is to retrace the exterior boundaries of two existing tracts of record and that no new parcels have been created; therefore, this survey is exempt from review as a subdivision being completed pursuant to 76-3-404 M.C.A.

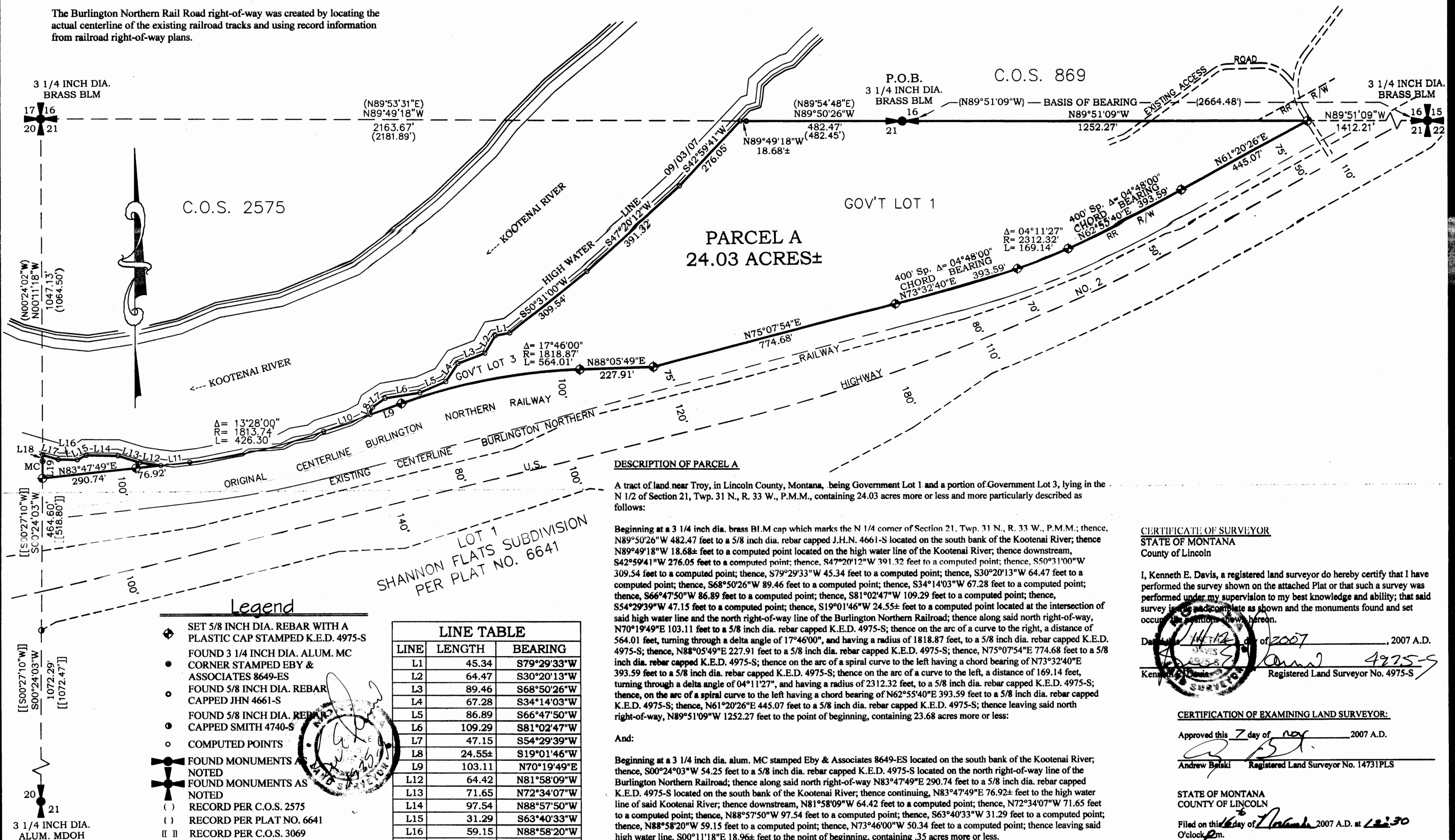

The Burlington Northern Rail Road right-of-way was created by locating the actual centerline of the existing railroad tracks and using record information from railroad right-of-way plans.



DESCRIPTION OF PARCEL A

A tract of land near Troy, in Lincoln County, Montana, being Government Lot 1 and a portion of Government Lot 3, lying in the N 1/2 of Section 21, Twp. 31 N., R. 33 W., P.M.M., containing 24.03 acres more or less and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 3 1/4 inch dia. brass BLM cap which marks the N 1/4 corner of Section 21, Twp. 31 N., R. 33 W., P.M.M.; thence, N89°50'26"W 482.47 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped J.H.N. 4661-S located on the south bank of the Kootenai River; thence N89°49'18"W 18.68± feet to a computed point located on the high water line of the Kootenai River; thence downstream, S42°59'41"W 276.05 feet to a computed point; thence, S47°20'12"W 391.32 feet to a computed point; thence, S50°31'00"W 309.54 feet to a computed point; thence, S79°29'33"W 45.34 feet to a computed point; thence, S30°20'13"W 64.47 feet to a computed point; thence, S68°50'26"W 89.46 feet to a computed point; thence, S34°14'03"W 67.28 feet to a computed point; thence, S66°47'50"W 86.89 feet to a computed point; thence, S81°02'47"W 109.29 feet to a computed point; thence, S54°29'39"W 47.15 feet to a computed point; thence, S19°01'46"W 24.55± feet to a computed point located at the intersection of said high water line and the north right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad; thence along said north right-of-way, N70°19'49"E 103.11 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence on the arc of a curve to the right, a distance of 564.01 feet, turning through a delta angle of 17°46'00", and having a radius of 1818.87 feet, to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence, N88°05'49"E 227.91 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence, N75°07'54"E 774.68 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence on the arc of a spiral curve to the left having a chord bearing of N73°32'40"E 393.59 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence on the arc of a curve to the left, a distance of 169.14 feet, turning through a delta angle of 04°11'27", and having a radius of 2312.32 feet, to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence, on the arc of a spiral curve to the left having a chord bearing of N62°55'40"E 393.59 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence, N61°20'26"E 445.07 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S; thence leaving said north right-of-way, N89°51'09"W 1252.27 feet to the point of beginning, containing 23.68 acres more or less:

Beginning at a 3 1/4 inch dia. alum. MC stamped Eby & Associates 8649-ES located on the south bank of the Kootenai River; thence, S00°24'03"W 54.25 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S located on the north right-of-way line of the Burlington Northern Railroad; thence along said north right-of-way N83°47'49"E 290.74 feet to a 5/8 inch dia. rebar capped K.E.D. 4975-S located on the south bank of the Kootenai River; thence continuing, N83°47'49"E 76.92± feet to the high water line of said Kootenai River; thence downstream, N81°58'09"W 64.42 feet to a computed point; thence, N72°34'07"W 71.65 feet to a computed point; thence, N88°57'50"W 97.54 feet to a computed point; thence, S63°40'33"W 31.29 feet to a computed point; thence, N88°58'20"W 59.15 feet to a computed point; thence, N73°46'00"W 50.34 feet to a computed point; thence leaving said high water line, S00°11'18"E 18.96± feet to the point of beginning, containing .35 acres more or less.

The aforescribed described Parcel A contains a total acreage of 24.03 acres more or less and is subject to and together with all appurtenant easements of record.
