From B.L.M. notes, subject to correction and approval, dated 1978: Sandstone 12 X 12 X 8 inches, firmly set 8 inches in the ground, marked 4 on the West face, and witnessed by the remains of the original bearing trees: A Larch stump, 10 inches diameter, bears S70°E., 82 links distance, with no visible marks.

> A Fir 24 inches diameter bears N58 3/4°W., 45 links distance, with B.T. visible on partially overgorwn blaze.

Set an iron post 30 inches long $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches diameter, 22 inches in the ground with brass cap marked



From which a new bearing tree:

A Fir 11 inches diameter, bears East 83 links distance, marked & S6 B.T. bury the original stone alongside and raise a flat mound of stone 3 feet diam. around post.

A Fir 30" diameter bears N 58 3/4"W 29.1 feet.


