CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner: 1/4 Corner, Secs. 3 & 34 T. 25N. & 26N. R. 29W. P.M.M. Lincoln County

1903 GLO Record: Set limestone and established 2 bearing trees.

1978 BLM Record: Found orig. stone, firmly set & marked w/ 1/4 on N. face and remains of original bearing trees.
A 24" stump, bears S75 1/2°W, 110 lks (72.6 ft.)
A 42" pine snag, bears N36°10'W, 68 lks (44.9 ft.), mk'd 1/4 S34 BT (GLO Record 57 lks)

Set an iron post 30" long, 2 1/2" diam., 22" in the ground, with brass cap. Buried orig. stone alongside.

New bearing trees:

- An 8" fir, bears S64°W, 22 lks (14.5 ft.), marked 1/4 S3 BT
- An 8" fir, bears N41°W, 21 lks (13.9 ft.), marked 1/4 S34 BT

2006 Record: Found 3 1/4" brass cap on 2 1/2" iron pipe, 7" above the ground. From which:
(Staples) A 42" dead, standing, Ponderosa pine, bears N36 1/4°W, 45.86 feet distant, scribed 1/4 S34 BT
A 15" dead, standing, Douglas fir, bears N44 1/4°W, 13.88 ft., marked with a BT tag & scribed 1/4 S34 BT
A 15" Douglas fir, healed scribe wound, bears S62 3/4°W, 14.67 ft

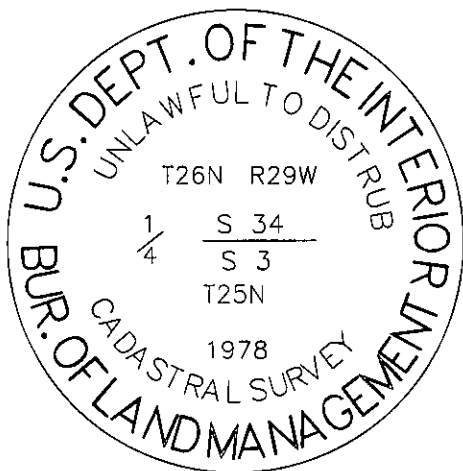
New bearing tree:

- An 18" Douglas fir, bears N21°W, 42.89 ft., scribed 1/4 S34 BT & BT tag

2009 Found: We find a standard BLM monument with a 3 1/4" brass cap, firmly set, in good condition, rising 6" above the ground, marked as shown below, from which:
A 15" Douglas fir, bears S63 3/4°W, 14.7 ft., with an overgrown blaze
A 15" Douglas fir snag, bears N44 1/4°W, 13.9 ft., with scribing visible
A 32" Ponderosa pine snag, bears N36 1/4°W, 45.9 ft., with scribing visible
A 14" Douglas fir, bears N21°W, 42.9 ft., with scribing visible

A galvanized steel post, bears West, 1.5 ft.

2009 Perpetuation: We establish no new reference monuments
We attached new P54-1 & P71-10 signs on steel post.
We paint red bands on the existing bearing trees, and attached USFS signs 54-3 & 54-9.
