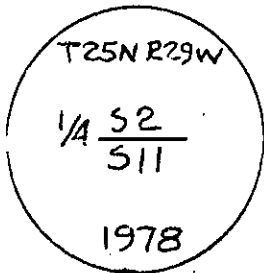

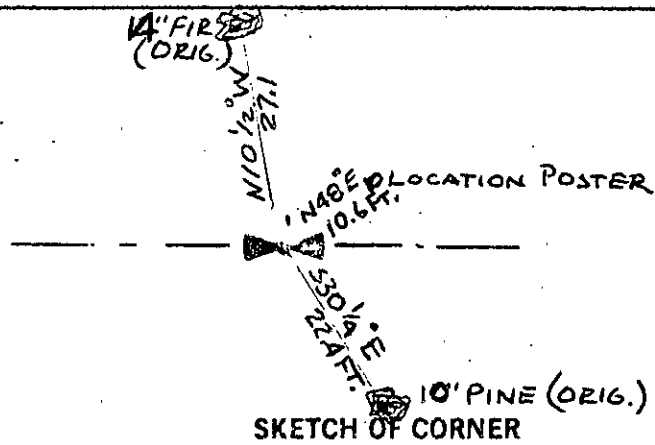
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner South 1/4 Corner Section 2 T. 25N R. 29W P.M.M. Lincoln County

1. 40.03 chains: set a shalestone, 24 X 10 X 6 inches, 18 inches in the ground, for 1/4 Section Corner, marked 1/4 on the N. face, from which a Pine 8 inches in diameter, bears S30 1/2 E 34 links distance, marked 1/4 S 2 B.T. A Fir, 10 inches in diameter, bears N 10 1/2 W., 41 links distance, marked 1/4 S 11 B.T.
2. Found: BLM brass capped monument (marked as shown below) from which a 14" Fir bears N 10 1/2 W 27.1 feet blaze overgrown. A 10" Pine bears S30 1/2 E 22.4 feet. Blaze overgrown. Both trees posted. A location poster bears N48°E 10.6 feet.
3. Painted monument and accessories with bright red paint.
