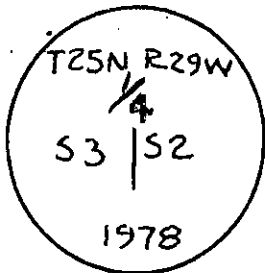


2. Description of evidence found, note also references in the record, state method of establishment of original corners.

6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

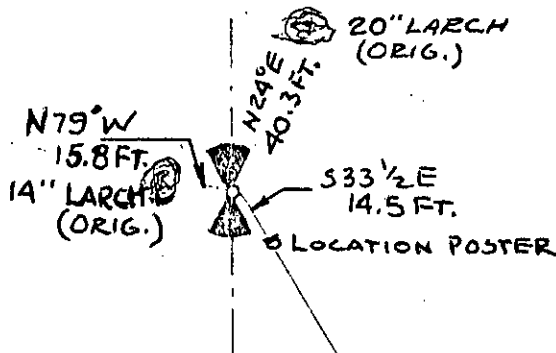
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner West 1/4 Corner Section 2 T. 25N R. 29W P.M.M. Lincoln County

1. 40.40 chains: Set a Limestone, 14 X 12 X 12 inches, 9 inches in the ground, for 1/4 Section Corner, marked 1/4 on the W. face, from which a Tamarack, 14 inches in diameter, bears N 24°E, 64 links distance, marked 1/4 S2 B.T. A Tamarack, 10 inches in diameter, bears N81°W 24 links distance, marked 1/4 S3 B.T.
2. Found: BLM brass capped monument (marked as shown below) from which a 20" Larch bears N24°E 40.3 feet (42.2 record) scribed B.T. visible on partially overgrown blaze. A 14" Larch bears N79°W 15.8 feet (N81°W record) some scribe visible on partially overgrown blaze. A location poster bears S33 1/2°E 14.5 feet. Both bearing trees are original and posted.
3. Painted monument and accessories with bright red paint.
