Found 3"X3" post rotted at base and lying on ground from which B.T.'s:

A 30" Tamarack stump bears N56°33'59"E 52.10 ft., scribes plainly visible.

A 24" Pine stump bears N38°09'54"W 49.70 ft., scribes plainly visible.

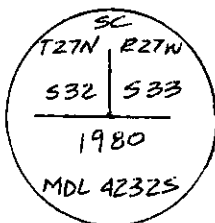
All other B.T.'s were obviously destroyed.

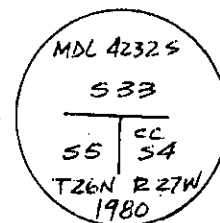

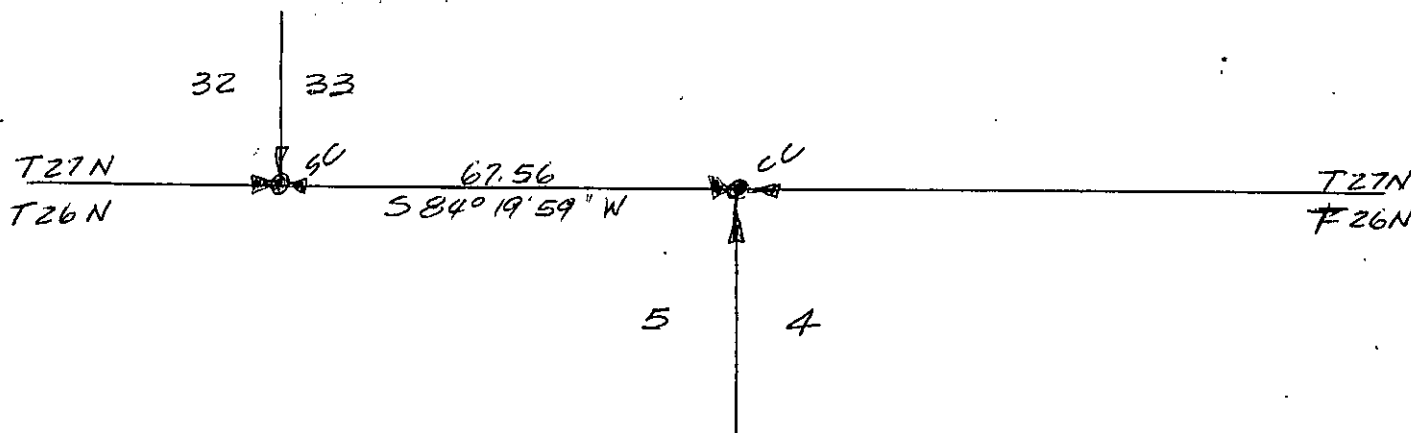

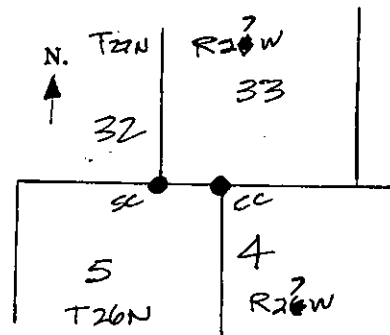
