

**CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION**  
(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

At the corner common to secs. 4, 3, 9, and 10, T. 26 N., R. 28 W., I found the original corner stone, 18 x 14 x 10 inches, firmly set 14 inches into ground with 5 notches on south face and 3 notches on east face, from which:

A 9-inch white fir bears  $45^\circ$  E., 37 links, scribing "R. 28 W., sec. 3" visible.  
(Record: 6-inch fir bears N.  $44^\circ$  E., 37 links.)

A 20-inch Douglas-fir bears S.  $31^\circ$  E., 37 links, scribing "R. 28 W., sec. 10" visible.  
(Record: 14-inch fir bears S.  $22^\circ$  E., 37 links.) Actual in the field.

A 17-inch Douglas-fir bears S.  $81^\circ 15'$  W., 19 links, scribing "T. 26 N., R. 28 W., section 9" visible.  
(Record: 14-inch fir bears S.  $81^\circ 15'$  W., 19 links.)

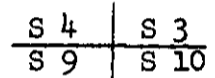
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

A 20-inch Douglas-fir bears N.  $28^\circ$  W., 57 links, scribing "R. 28 W., sec. 4" visible.  
(Record: 12-inch fir bears N.  $30^\circ 5'$  W., 57 links.)

Date of work: May 21, 1964

At the center point of the original corner stone, I set a 2-inch galvanized iron pipe 26 inches into the ground with brass cap of pipe marked:

T. 26 N., R. 28 W.,

I buried the original stone alongside the iron pipe, from which:

9-inch spruce bears S.  $23^\circ$  E., 30 links, scribed "S 10 RM."  
9-inch spruce bears N.  $17^\circ \frac{1}{2}$  W., 21 links, scribed "S 4 RM."

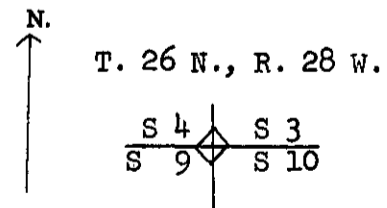
