1903 GLO Record: Set 3 ft. fir post. Established 4 bearing trees

1964 BLM Record: Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2" diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap, from which:

Original bearing trees:

An aspen, 16 ins. diam., bears S04 1/2°E, 247 lks (163.0 ft.), with illegible scribing

An aspen, 16 ins. diam., bears S16 1/4°W, 143 lks (94.4 ft.), with illegible scribing

Corner is 27 lks (17.8 ft.), N. of fence intersection extending E, SE & W.

1985 Record: Found a BLM monument, flush with ground, with a brass cap marked as described in the (Hill) BLM record, from which the following references:

An aspen snag, bears S18°W, 143.6 lks (94.8 ft.), scribing visible

An aspen blow down, bears S02°W, 242.4 lks (160.0 ft.), scribing visible

A fence corner post, bears East, 1.0 ft.

A fence corner post, bears S02°W, 17.9 ft.

New bearing tree

An aspen, 13 ins. diam., bears S48°W, 108.2 lks (71.4 ft.) marked T26N R28W S32 BT

Set guard post 2.0 ft. south from corner

2009 Found: We find a standard BLM monument with a 3 1/4" BLM brass cap, firmly set, in good condition, set flush with the ground, in E-W fence line, marked as shown below, from which:

An 18" aspen, bears S48°W, 71.4 ft., with scribing visible, and a 1985 BT tag marked "N48°W 71.4"

An 8" fence post, bears East 1.2 ft.

Decayed tree remains, bears S18°W, 94.8 ft.

Decayed tree remains, bears S5°E, 16.3 ft., w/ blank BT tag

2009 Perpetuation: From the found monument we establish the following reference monuments:

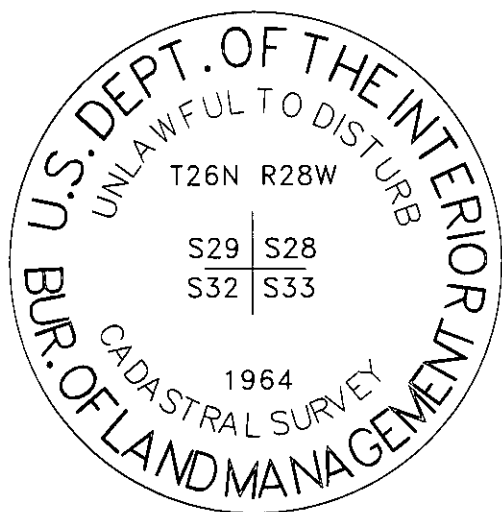
An 8" wood fence post, bears East, 1.2 ft.

A 14" aspen, bears S04°E, 152.0 ft., scribed T26N R28W S33 BT

We posted USFS decals P54-1 & P71-10 on steel post, 1.8 ft. south of monument.

We paint red bands on the existing & new bearing tree, and attached USFS signs 54-3 & 54-9.
