

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION
(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

At the corner common to secs. 30, 29, 31, and 32, T. 26 N., R. 28 W.,
I found the original corner stone, 12 x 10 x 5 inches, loosely set with 1 notch on
south face and 5 notches on east face.
(Record: Same.)

From which:

An 8-inch larch bears N. 11° E., 45 links, scribing partly overgrown; "R 2" visible.
(Record: 6-inch pine bears N. 11° E., 45 links.)

A 7-inch lodgepole pine bears S. 85°45' E., 49 links, scribing R 28 W., sec. 32" visible.
(Record: 5-inch pine, S. 85°45' E., 69 links.) Actual in the field.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

A 16-inch larch snag bears S. 13° W., 9 links, scribing
"T. 26 N., R. 28 W., sec. 31" visible.
(Record: 18-inch pine, S. 19°30' W., 9 links.) Actual in the field. T. 26 N., R. 28 W.

Date of work: May 19, 1964

A 9-inch lodgepole pine bears N. 42°30' W., 37 links, scribing
"T. 26 N., R. 28 W., sec. 30 BT" visible.
(Record: 6-inch pine bears N. 42°30' W., 37 links.)

I set a 2-inch galvanized iron pipe 26 inches into ground at
center point of original stone with brass cap marked:

858ES -- IMT -- ART

I buried the original stone alongside the iron pipe, from which
10-inch lodgepole pine bears S. 24° W., 51 links, scribed "S. 31 RM."

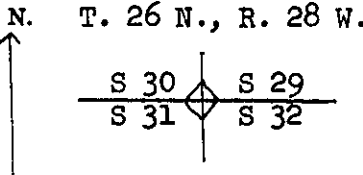
