

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION
(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

At the 1/4 corner common to secs. 5 and 32, T.'s 25 and 26 N., R. 28 W.,
I found the original stone, 12 x 10 x 5 inches, firmly set 8 inches into the ground
with "1/4" on north face.
(Record: Same.)

From which:

An 8-inch lodgepole pine bears S. 27°45' W., 19 links, scribed "1/4 S 5 BT."
The tree is alive and in good condition.
(Record: 7-inch pine bears S. 27°45' W., 19 links.)

A 10-inch lodgepole pine bears N. 36°10' W., 19 links, scribed "1/4 S 32 BT."
The tree is alive and in good condition.
(Record: 8-inch pine bears N. 36°10' W., 19 links.)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

I set a 2-inch galvanized iron pipe 26 inches into the ground
at center point of the original stone with brass cap marked:
