

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION
(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

At the position for the 1/4 corner common to secs. 5 and 4, T. 26 N., R. 28 W.,
I found that original corner stone was gone. A private survey T-iron was set at corner,
From which:

A 12-inch Douglas-fir snag bears N. 52°30' E., 33 links, scribing "1/4 S 4" visible.
(Record: 9-inch fir bears N. 52°30' E., 33 links.)
A 10-inch Douglas fir bears S. 16° W., 21 links, scribing "1/4 S 5" visible; tree
is alive and in good condition.
(Record: 8-inch fir bears S. 16° W., 21 links.)

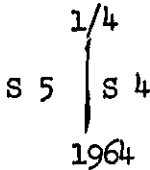
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Corner set from original record bearing and distance;
I set a 2-inch galvanized iron pipe 26 inches into
the ground, with brass cap marked:

Date of work: May 21, 1964
T. 26 N., R 28 W.,

I buried private survey T-iron alongside the iron pipe,
From which:

5-inch Douglas-fir bears N. 82½° E., 24 links, scribed "S 4 RM."

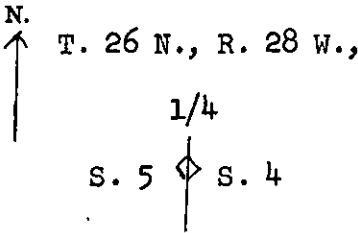
