

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION  
(REFERENCE FSH 5681.65)

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

At the position for the 1/4 corner common to secs. 29 and 32, T. 26 N., R. 28 W.,  
I found original wood post lying on ground. It was scribed "1/4 sec. 29" on north face and  
"32" on south face;  
I found underground remains of wood post, about 3 inches square, bottom of post was 12 inches  
below the surface.  
(Record: 3-inch wood stake, scribed "1/4 sec. 29" on north face and "32 on south face.)

From which:

An 18-inch larch bears S. 9°15' W., 21 links, scribing overgrown.  
(Record: 18-inch larch bears S. 9°15' W., 21 links.)  
A 27-inch ponderosa pine bears N. 22°30' W., 23 links, scribing overgrown.  
(Record: 22-inch pine bears N. 22°30' W., 23 links.)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED  
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

In the center of the remains of the rotted wooden post, I set a  
2-inch galvanized iron pipe 26 inches into the ground with brass  
cap marked:

T 26 N., R. 28 W.  
S 29

I buried the original wood post alongside the iron pipe, from which:

11-inch white fir bears S. 44° W., 47 links, scribed "S 32 RM."  
10-inch white fir bears N. 21° E., 48 links, scribed "S 29 RM."
